What is TRIO?

TRIO programs have been established across the US to make it possible for more individuals to attend, and graduate from, college. Funded by the federal government, TRIO programs provide support, services, and resources to nearly one million students nationwide.

TRIO programs are designed to serve individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds, first-generation college students, and those with disabilities.

These are just some of the ways TRIO programs assist and support their participants.

TRIO programs...

- ▶ offer advice on course selection.
- ▶ provide tutoring.
- ▶ help students prepare for college entrance exams, including the ACT and SAT.
- ▶ provide academic counseling.
- ▶ offer financial and economic literacy education.
- ▶ provide information on post-secondary opportunities.
- ▶ help students fill out college applications.
- ▶ provide career counseling.
- ▶ provide information on financial aid and help completing the FAFSA.

The name TRIO refers to the three original programs: Talent Search, Upward Bound, and Student Support Services.
