

# Homework Tips **for Students**

## Create a study plan

After studying for 30 minutes, take a short break. Get up and stretch or get a snack. Resist the temptation to text a friend or go online. Save those things for later.

## Reward yourself

Use rewards to encourage yourself to get your studying done. For example, you could reward yourself with phone, TV, or video game time once you finish your homework.

## Stay positive and persistent

Maintain a positive mindset and approach your homework with enthusiasm. Be persistent in your efforts and keep pushing forward, even when facing challenges.

## Review and revise

Set aside time to review your completed assignments. Check for errors, make necessary revisions, and use feedback from peers and teachers to improve your future work.
