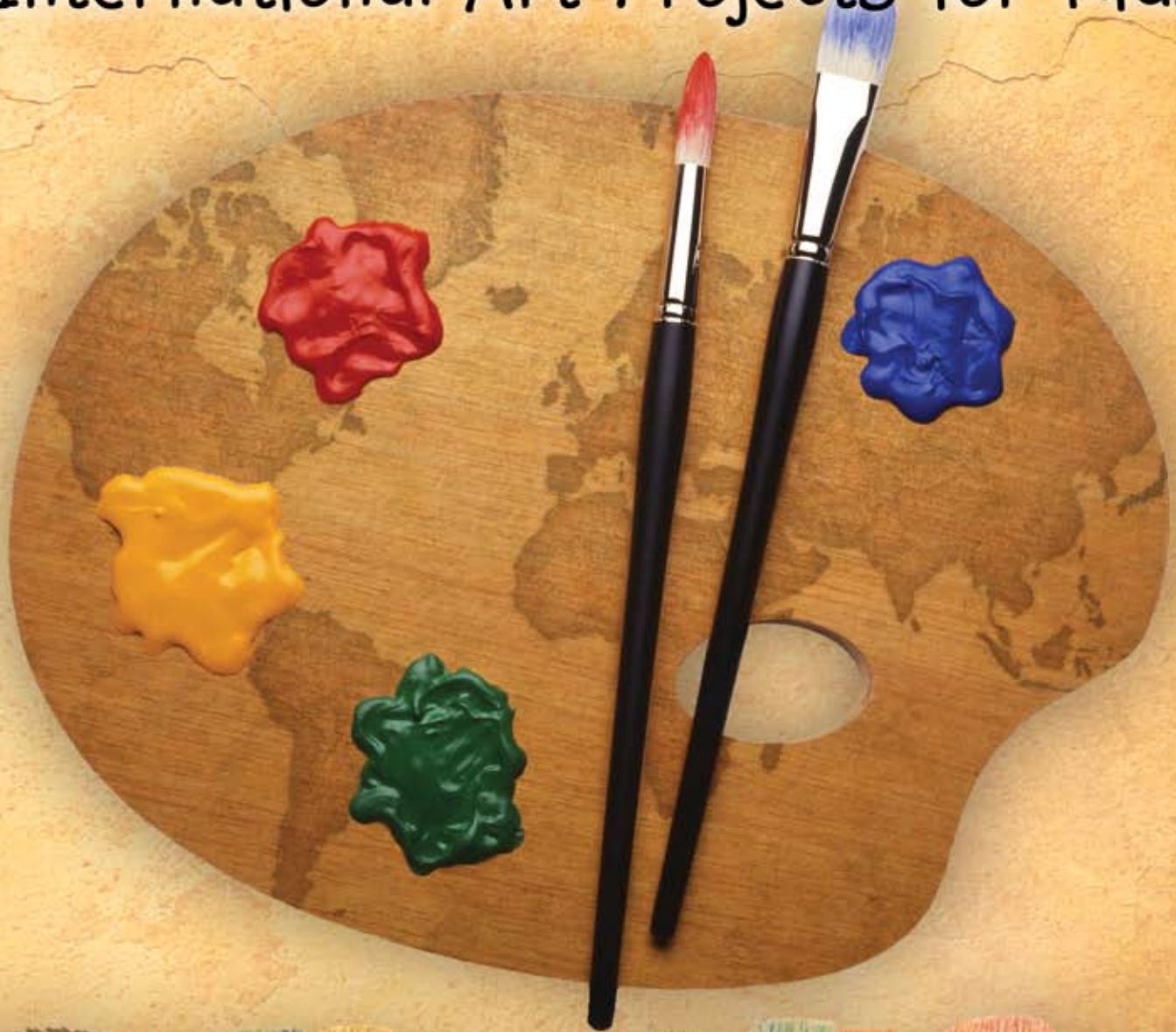

Stonehenge ☆

Stonehenge, located near Salisbury England, is one of Britain's most famous structures. To this day, no one can say with certainty why or how these structures came to be. Is this an early form of architecture? Is it an ancient pagan temple? Is it an early, primitive clock or calendar? No one knows. We only know that it is a **megalithic structure**. A megalithic structure is made with huge stones that show little evidence of having been carved or sculpted. It appears they were simply brought in their natural state, set up in a design, and left without any mortar or other fastening agent. Sculpt your own version of Stonehenge with this edible clay.



1. Combine peanut butter, milk, and honey in a bowl. Mix thoroughly.
2. Sculpt your own version of Stonehenge on foam board or cardboard.
