Instructions

Maurice Pledger's Wildlife World Sticker Book has gone out of print and been replaced by *Animal Kingdom Sticker Activity Book: Into the Wild* (ISBN 9781626861077), also by Maurice Pledger.

Please use the text that follows as a substitute for the text in your book. You may want to mark each section in your book with a pencil to make it easier to know when to refer to this alternate text. Generally, the paragraph number is counted from the start of the noted section.

★ UNIT 2: JAMESTOWN ★

Lesson 2, Part 2E

page 118, paragraph 3:

In the *Animal Kingdom Sticker Activity Book: Into the Wild*, have the student complete the pages for freshwater fish on pages 52-55.

✿ Choose one of the fish on pages 54-55 and look it up...

Lesson 3, Part 2F

page 133, paragraph 1:

Have your Junior complete pages 26-29 in the *Animal Kingdom Sticker Activity Book: Into the Wild* to discover things found by the sea.

Lesson 5, Part 2E

page 162, paragraph 1:

While the older students work on the geography lesson, have your Junior work in the *Animal Kingdom Sticker Activity Book: Into the Wild*. Add a turtle sticker to page 49, "Reptiles and Amphibians." Add the reptile stickers to page 50, "Snakes, frogs, and other friends," and review the characteristics of a reptile. Have the student tell some things that make each of the animals on the page a reptile.

Lesson 5, Part 3E

page 166, paragraph 2:

Add the stickers of "Birds who live by the water" on pages 62-63 of the *Animal Kingdom Sticker Activity Book: Into the Wild*. Note how their body structure is particularly suited to water life and fishing.

Lesson 4, Part 2E

page 231, paragraph 2:

In the *Animal Kingdom Sticker Activity Book: Into the Wild*, have the student add a picture of a frog to page 49 (“Reptiles and Amphibians”) and the pictures of amphibians to page 51.

Lesson 5, Part 2E

page 247, paragraph 1:

Review characteristics of mammals using “The Vertebrate Rap,” if necessary. Have the student complete *Animal Kingdom Sticker Activity Book: Into the Wild*, pages 64-71, placing the stickers of mammals in their proper places.

Lesson 5, Part 5

Add new activity to Enrichment Activities, page 339:

- Have your student complete pages 12-15 in the *Animal Kingdom Sticker Activity Book: Into the Wild* to explore some of the wildlife Daniel Boone may have encountered.

Lesson 6, Part 2E

page 344, paragraph 2:

Have the student complete pages 38-39 (“All sorts of Insects”), pages 40-41 (“Beetles, bees, and other insects”) and pages 42-43 (“Other creepy-crawlies”) in the *Animal Kingdom Sticker Activity Book: Into the Wild*. You may want to go on a bug hunt outside and place a sticker for each kind of bug you find.

Lesson 6, Part 4E

page 347, paragraph 1:

Have your Junior play the Animal I.D. concentration game with your older student, and/or have them complete *Animal Kingdom Sticker Activity Book: Into the Wild* pages 44-47 about “Butterflies and moths” and “Pond Insects.”

Lesson 1, Part 5

Add new activity to Enrichment Activities, page 364:

- Have your Junior complete pages 6-11 in the *Animal Kingdom Sticker Activity Book: Into the Wild* to discover wildlife found in a meadow.

Lesson 2, Part 5

Add new activity to Enrichment Activities, page 379:

- Have your Junior complete pages 16-21 in the *Animal Kingdom Sticker Activity Book: Into the Wild* to explore animals that Lewis and Clark might have seen along the river on their journey.

Lesson 4, Part 5

Add new activity to Enrichment Activities, page 409:

- Have your Junior complete pages 30-35 in the *Animal Kingdom Sticker Activity Book: Into the Wild* to explore animals that Lewis and Clark might have encountered during their trip across the Rocky Mountains.

Lesson 6, Part 3F

page 430, paragraph 2:

Have the student complete pages 56-61 of the *Animal Kingdom Sticker Activity Book: Into the Wild* about “All Sorts of Birds.” Do any of these birds appear in your yard?
