Plants and Pets

Does your pet chew on the leaves of your plants? If so, you might consider choosing one that is KNOWN to be non-toxic to dogs and cats.

This information can be found on the American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (ASPCA) website at: www.aspca.org. Their website offers an extensive searchable database for toxic & non-toxic plants of all types. Be sure to use botanical names in their database.

If you do have a pet that chews on foliage, consider avoiding the plants listed below as they are toxic to dogs and cats. At the very least, consider placing them where your pet doesn't have access to chew on them.
