# Plants for Reptile Enclosures

Looking for plants for your humid or dryland vivarium? The plants listed are generally deemed safe for reptiles. Keep in mind that some reptiles may still have sensitivities to these particular plants. So you might want to consult a vet for your specific type of pet.

Since our tropicals are supplied by many different growers from all over the country (with many different types of growing practices), we recommend rinsing plant leaves prior to placing in your pet's habitat.

We generally offer most of these plants year-round. However, some such as jasmine, Tahitian bridal veil or Norfolk Island Pine will be more readily available when in season.
