PAYMENT

RULES AND EXPECTAIONS

Attire

- > Students must come to class in **jeans** (NO leggings or shorts) and **toe-covering shoes** (**boots** prefered but any shoes that completely cover the feet and toes will be accepted. Little to no traction is preferable).
- > Helmets will be required for students of ALL ages while on horseback. It is strongly recommended that students purchase their own equestrian helmets in their size to use for lessons. Helmets will be available for Lease until personal helmets can be purchased (we are happy to help find and select an appropriate helmet).
- ➤ Please be aware that seasonal weather may affect lessons. For Summer, please think about short-sleeved shirts. For Fall, a jacket or coat is suggested (if you have one that is **not** the rain-slicker material that "swishes" when you touch it, please bring that instead!)

Participation

> Students will be sent home with a couple worksheets or links for videos to watch. Please complete and return sheets to review in following class. These will not be difficult but will help ingrain the information as well as be a review of the day's lesson and prepare for the next week.

Safety

- > Students **under** 6 years old or those registered for the Exposure lessons MUST have a parent or guardian present at EVERY lesson. Please dress accordingly.
- > Students **above** 6 years old or those registered for Regular/Private/Natural Horsemanship/Colt-Starting lessons MUST have a parent or guardian present at the FIRST lesson. At subsequent lessons, parens must make sure they communicate drop-offs with Instructor but do not have to stay if they choose not to.
- Lessons will be held outside so it is recommended (but not required) that students wear sunscreen or hats and bring full waterbottles to help minimize sun exposure and heat exhaustion.
- ➤ Horses are independent prey animals capable of thinking and making decisions. Students MUST be able to respond and follow instructions to ensure optimal safety for horses and all students.

➤ Waiver and Liability Release Form must be **signed and returned** before any student will be allowed to participate in horseback riding lessons.
