FABRIC(SQUABS & CUSHIONS) -

All cushion covers that we manufacture are removable, with a zip placed along the back edge of the cushions. This allows for the cover to be removed and cleaned as necessary, however we do recommend trying to keep cleaning to a minimum especially when using strong cleaning products.

FOAM -

All foams we use from our primary foam supplier, Dunlop Foams, are designed for comfort as well as easy care. If you happen to spill something or dirty the foam supplied in or with your order, the simplest way to clean it is to remove the cushion cover, and rinse water through the foam piece until the substance is removed, and then allow to dry in the sun or a warm area for 1-2 days. For loose filings such as Ergo Fill, ensure you leave it inside its bag for rinsing.

FABRIC SPOT CLEANING -

Extreme caution should be taken if considering treatment of velvets and pocket weaves with stain repellent products. Some high pile velvet and pocket weave jacquards may change in surface character if stain repellent treatments are incorrectly applied. Extra care should be taken to pre-test for these fabrics.

PROFESSIONAL CLEANING FREQUENCY -

This is determined by the furniture use, your own maintenance, upkeep and environmental conditions. As a good 'rule of thumb' overall cleaning is recommended every 12 months for most family room lounges.
