Chew Guard Installation Instructions



Items you will need

Phillips screwdriver (manual or powered)

Description

These four pieces of wood will be assembled, *within the condo*, into a ring that fits snugly against the existing inner sills of the condo. This serves two purposes: it gives the bunnies something to chew on, while also protecting the actual inner sill of the condo.

Figure 1 shows the corner of an assembled condo. The regular inner sill the condo has been colored red. The chew guard is the ring of wood inside the inner sill. (Your condo inner sill is not red; this color has been added to the figure image to allow you to easily see the inner sill.)

The ring is built so the short ends screw into the long pieces of wood.



Instructions

1. Slide one short piece (approximately 22") into the condo on the left hand side, with countersunk screw hole facing towards the outside (i.e. towards the condo sill).
2. Slide one long piece through the cage wire (it won't fit through the door). Lap the short piece over the end of the long piece. Firmly and slowly screw these pieces together. You'll have to do this inside the condo, inserting the drill through the wire. Be careful! A set of helping hands might be in order.
3. Insert the other long piece through the cage wire, and lap the other end of the short piece over the end of the long piece. Screw these together in the same fashion.
4. Insert the remaining short side into the condo, and lap both ends over the two long pieces, and screw them together.

You're done! Now let the little stinkers chew until their heart's content!
