

Party Deck Assembly

You can place the deck where you wish. Our example places it on the left side of the condo, five squares of wire up from the condo floor.

Hold one rail with the groove facing to the right. Slide it into the condo from the outside as shown below.

Sit the rail down so the notches at each end "grab" the wire.

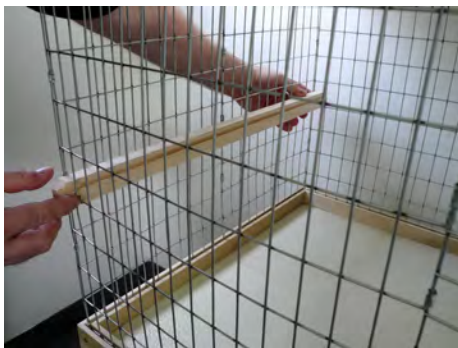
Next, open the condo door and stick the hard floor of the deck inside.

Starting at one end, stick the board into the groove in the rail. Snug it in fully, checking it is seated from one end to the other. It will wiggle a bit, that's part of the design!

Hold it in place with one hand while doing the next step.

Hold the remaining rail so the groove is facing to the left. Slide it through the wire, catching the hard floor in the groove, all the way to the back. Again sit the rail down so the notches at each end "grab" the wire.

Lay the carpeting on top. Tada!
