

Crown Casino - Melbourne "Calm Networks" Check Valves

Discussions around "calm networks" usually focus on Municipal networks, however, this is not always the case. It is often said that "a check valve is a check valve" but those who know, are well aware that this is almost never the case and that each different style of check valve is designed to be used in specific applications.

Recently the desire to have a calm network, and an incorrect check valve selection led to a less than satisfactory result for a client in Australia. Crown Resorts is one of Australia's largest entertainment groups with its core business investments in the integrated resorts sector. In Australia, Crown operates two of Australia's leading integrated resorts in Crown Melbourne and Crown Perth.

A recent high pressure pump installation saw the use of what seems to be the "go-to" selection in the heating and ventilating section sector, the double door wafer check. While this style of check may indeed have its uses, it should definitely not be the go-to for all applications. There are four main areas that should be addressed when making proper check valve selections:

- (1) Non slam characteristics
- (2) Head loss
- (3) Application
- (4) Cost



Typically, we see cost as the only deciding factor, and that may suit the budget, it more times than not, does not deliver the solution that the client is actually looking for, and often the end result is noise, which in a high-class integrated resort, is definitely not what the client was looking for.

So the end result in this case was noisy water hammer and damage to components of the piping system and this occurred during commissioning of a new system. There was immediate pressure to obtain locally a number of high-quality, 25 Bar rated, non-surge design, metal seated check valves.
