






Camoflague consists of Dark Olive Green FS 34096, Gunship Gray FS 36118 and Medium Sea Gray FS 36270 with Lt Ghost Gray FS 36375 on the bottom surfaces. Use the black stencils on this sheet. This aircraft has the nose bay doors without rivets, see photo.



The AH-1Zs flown by the Royal Bahrainian Air Force and the Czech Air Force have doors that do not have the visible rivets found on most AH-1Zs.

AH-1Zs flown by the Pakistan Army, RBAF and the CZAF have markings on the tail rotor blades, they have also been seen on some Marine Zulus.
