Our laminated cottons are buttery soft (you won't believe it...not stiff at all) and water resistant on top with a natural cotton back (which makes it possible to scrub out stains). All of our fabrics meet or exceed CPSIA standards and are produced in a sustainable way. Choose hook/loop or tie waists. Our hook/loop is sewn close to the center front of the apron so that the child can see where they are attaching it and longer on one side to allow for an adjustable fit that gets around smaller and larger children.


## Cloth: $100 \%$ Cotton

Choose these cloth, $100 \%$ cotton, fully-lined aprons for dusting, food preparation, or other activities where you want water absorption instead of resistance.

## PHONOGRAM DICTIONARY

When children start reading books, they will inevitably encounter words that they have difficulty deciphering. The Phonogram Dictionary is an excellent tool to help them read independently at this stage.

The Phonogram Dictionary lists the common spelling variations on tabs like an address book. When children are reading and find a spelling they don't understand, they can scan the tabs to find the spelling that is troubling. When they open to that page, they see a representation of the key sound as it looks on the sandpaper letters. For example, if they open the 'a-e' tab, they will see a small image of the 'ai' green sandpaper letter (see photo).
