

Using your Geography Folders

Cut each continent out by hand and affix it to a blue folder (we used a glue stick). You will need seven folders in total (one per continent). Use each continent's folder to house about 10 images of life on that continent. Be sure that the folders contain parallel images (e.g., each continent folder should include one mountain, one street scene, one beach, etc.). Rotate the images regularly to keep the material

alive throughout the year. Add to your collection of cards by asking families to contribute post cards, photos, and other memorabilia from their travels.

You may wish to display all seven folders on a low, top shelf in a wooden pot lid holder (used as a folder holder). Keep the folders accessible so the children can choose them independently (once they have received an initial presentation).
