IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE RETAIN THIS USER GUIDE FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

When using electrical appliances, basic precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, including the following:

- 1) Read all instructions before using this fireplace
- 2) The fireplace is hot when in use. To avoid burns, do not let bare skin touch hot surfaces. Keep combustible material such as furniture, cushions, bedding, paper, clothes, curtains at least 3 feet from the front of the unit
- 3) Extreme caution is necessary when any heater is used near children and whenever the unit is left operating and unattended.
- 4) Do not operate a fireplace with a damaged cord or plug, or if the heater has malfunctioned, the fireplace has drooped or damaged in any manner
- 5) Not all fireplaces are suitable for use in bathrooms or laundry facilities. Please consult with individual product literature to confirm suitability
- 6) Do not run the cord under carpeting. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners or the like. Arrange the cord away from traffic area and where it will not be tripped over

UNPACKING AND TESTING APPLIANCE

Carefully remove the appliance from the box.

Prior to installing the appliance, test to make sure the appliance operates properly by plugging the power supply cord into a conveniently located 120 Volt grounded outlet. Test all aspects of its operation (manual switches, remote and heater) to make sure all components operate correctly.


As with most electronic devices, your electric fireplace has been designed to operate at temperatures between 5 $^{\circ}$ C (41 $^{\circ}$ F) and 35 $^{\circ}$ C (95 $^{\circ}$ F). During the cold winter months, allow the fireplace to reach room temperature before turning it on.

NOTE: There may be trace odor during the first few minutes of initial use. This is harmless, normal, and will never occur again.

GROUNDING APPLIANCE

This appliance is for use on 120 volts. The cord has a plug as shown in (A). An adapter as shown in (C) is available for connecting three-blade grounding type plugs to two-slot receptacles. The green grounding lug extending from the adapter must be connected to a permanent ground such as a properly grounded outlet box. The adapter should not be used if a three-slot grounded receptacle is available.

To disconnect appliance, turn controls to off, then remove plug from outlet.


CHOOSING A LOCATION FOR THE FIREPLACE

Plan where to place and frame the fireplace. Before installation consider the following:

- 1. The location of the fireplace must allow for wall and ceiling clearances.
- 2. Consider a location where the fireplace screen will not be exposed to direct sunlight from windows or doors.
- A 15 ampere, 120 Volt, 60 Hz branch circuit with proper ground must be available at the location. A dedicated branch circuit should be provided to avoid circuit breakers to trip or fuses to blow.



OUTDOOR INSTALLATIONS

The TRD series of electric fireplaces are suitable for installation in outdoor areas protected from direct water impingement. In addition to maintaining the listed mantel and combustibles clearances, a rain protection overhang factor of 1/2 shall be constructed to the front and to each side of the installed appliance. See illustration below. All wiring connections to line power shall be in accordance with local building code requirements. Inquires about local codes and regulations must be done prior to installation.




The overhang (A) must extend at least 1/2 the roof-line height (B). Height is measured from the base of the fireplace.

For example: if the roof-line (B) is 8' above the base of the fireplace, the overhang (A) must be at least 4'.

MANTEL CLEARANCE

The clearance to the mantel should be 1" minimum when a mantel is applied (Measurement is taken from the glass front).



INSTALLATION- BUILT-IN

NOTE: Due to the many different materials used to build walls, it is highly recommended that you consult your local builder before you install this appliance on a wall.


Preparation

- 1. Select a location that is not prone to moisture and is located at least 0.91m or 3 feet away from combustible materials such as curtains, drapes, furniture, bedding, paper, etc.
- 2. Mark the desired location on the floor and store the appliance in a safe, dry and dust free place.
- 3. Prepare a wall with a framed opening to accommodate the size of your unit. Leave at least 1/4" (6mm) around the edge of the appliance. Any new wiring must be done in compliance with local and national codes and other applicable regulations.

Prior to installing, test the appliance to make sure the appliance is fully operational by plugging the power supply cord into a 120 Volt grounded outlet.




INSTALLATION


NOTE: Fireplace removal should be a simple process. The reason for removal of a fireplace may vary and include changing the PCB, heater and fan.

Take note of the air intake vent located at the bottom and behind the front trim.


1. Unscrew 4 screws and take offf the trim. (CAUTION: Once the trim has been removed the glass is not secured. Use extreme caution when removing the glass to prevent damage)




2. When the trim is removed, take off the front glass panel.




3. Unscrew the screws located on each side and take off the inner side steel panels.




4. Put the trim back onto the appliance and fasten with screws.(NOTE: This step is to make sure that the fireplace fits the wall opening well and there is no gap between the trim and the wall after installation)




5. Put the fireplace into the wall opening and fix it to the wall by screwing 2 screws each side.



6. Remove the trim following STEP 1. Screw back the inner side steel panels.



7. Put back the front glass panel and screw back the trim after you finish the media installation.



HARDWIRE INSTALLATION

Turn off the appliance completely and let cool before servicing. Only a qualified technician should service and repair this electric fireplace.

If it is necessary to hard wire this appliance, a qualified electrician must remove the cord connection and wire the appliance directly to the household wiring .

This appliance must be electrically connected and grounded in accordance with local codes, if hard wired. In the absence of local codes, use the current CSA C22.1 CANADIAN ELECTRICAL CODE in Canada or the current ANSI/NFPA 70 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE in the United States.

1. Remove the cover plate from the left side of the appliance by removing the two screws, as shown below. Unscrew and remove power cord.





2. Attach the wiring to the junction block. Please make sure the live wire goes into the "L", the neutral wire into "N" and the ground wire into "G".





3. Replace the steel plate and screws.

MEDIA OPTIONS

The media that come with this appliance are Birch Log Set, "Clear glass", Amber glass, one (1) bag of Black Vermiculite and one (1) bag of White Vermiculite.



MEDIA INSTALLATION

Unscrew 4 screws and take off the trim. (NOTE: Keep hold of the front glass as it may fall down automatically when the trim is removed.)



INSTALLING THE DECORATIVE MEDIA

Pour the fire glass media into the tray. Feel free to use any combination of the fire glass media that you find most appealing. Put back the trim and front glass after you finish installing the fire glass.

OPERATION

The Fireplace operates by using either the touch panel located on the upper left hand corner or by remote control.

Plug the fireplace into a 15 Amp wall socket.

MANUAL OPERATION



- 1. Press 😃 to turn on and off the fireplace.
- 2. Press to adjust the flame brightness. There are 6 brightness levels (L6-L1) and an off(OF) position. Each time the flame button is pressed, the brightness of the flame decrease.
 - press the flame button for 10 seconds, the timing indicator light on and will rapidly blinks, at this time, You can use the TuyaSmart APP to connect to the fireplace.
- 3. Press to adjust the moodlight brightness. There are 11 brightness levels (d11-d2), dynamic condition (d1), and the OFF (OF) setting you can cycle through.
- 4. Press to set the turn-off time, 30min-1h-2h-3h-4h-5h-6h-7h-8h-t0. The indicator light the current timing. If the timing in off position, the second press will show 30. Multiple times to set operating duration to OF, 30 min, 1h, 2h, 3h, 4h, 5h, 6h, 7h, 8h.
- 5. Press **W** or the first time to display the current setting temperature, press the button again to clear the current temperature. If the heater in off position, the second press will show 22 ℃ (72 ℙ). Multiple times to set ambient temperatures at 22 ℂ (72 ℙ), 23 ℂ (74 ℙ), 24 ℂ (76 ℙ), 25 ℂ (78 ℙ), 26 ℂ (80 ℙ), 27 ℂ (82 ℙ), 28 ℂ (84 ℙ), 15 ℂ (52 ℙ), 16 ℂ (54 ℙ), 17 ℂ (56 ℙ), 18 ℂ (58 ℙ), 19 ℂ (60 ℙ), 20 ℂ (62 ℙ), 21 ℂ (64 ℙ). Temperature unit convert functionZ When the heater is on, press and hold the "**W**" Button for 5 seconds, current temperature unit display will convert to another temperature unit.

REMOTE CONTROL OPERATION

For remote to function make sure the fireplace is plugged in and the remote has batteries.

Important: When operating the remote make sure you point the remote to the center of the fireplace. Each time you press the button, the buzzer inside the unit will beep once. It takes some time for the receiver to respond to the transmitter. Do not PRESS the buttons more than once within two seconds for correct operation.

Set the current time of the remote control

Press the time and date. When one of the "Sun" "Mon" "Tue" "Wed" "Thu" "Fri" "Sat" is flashing, press or to set the day of the week, press to confirm day of the week and then enter hour setting. Press or to set the hour, press to confirm the hour and then enter minute setting. Press or to set the minute and press to confirm the minute and finish time setting.



- Press this Power button to turn on and off the fireplace.
- Press this Timer button to set the time to turn off the fireplace. The available settings range from 30 minutes to 8 hours. As shown in the following: 0:30 1:00 1:30 2:00 2:30 3:00 3:30 4:00 4:30 5:00 5:30 6:00 6:30 7:00 7:30 8:00. Once you have set the timer, the icon will be displayed on the LCD screen of the remote control. Press this button again to cancel the timer setting and the icon disappears.
- Each time the Heater Button is pressed, the power of the heater will change. As shown the following: H1- H2- AUTO (22°C) OFF (no display)

H1 means the firepalce on Low Heat/600W.
H2 means the fireplace on High Heat/1200W.

AUTO means fireplace can automatically adjust to the temperature you set. When in AUTO, you can set the desired temperature with or keys. You can switch temperature between Celsius and Fahrenheit with or keys. When it is on Auto mode, fireplace operate at 1200W.



Press this button to adjust the speed of the flame. There are 3 options: High-Medium-Low.



The Ember bed /moodlight Button turn the ember bed or moodlight on and off.When in on position,the display screen of the remote control shows AD1.,when the number "1" flash, you can set the color with or keys. There are 10 different colors (AD1-10) and dynamic condition (AD11) to choose from.



Press the Flame button to turn on and off the Flame. When in ON position, the LCD screen of the remote control shows 6 6 6. Press or or to change the brightness of each color flame.



7 Day Timer Function

Press once, 7 days from Monday to Sunday will display on the LCD screen of the remote control, press within 5 seconds to enter 7 day timer function. When "Sun" flashes, press or to select the day that you want to set, press to confirm your setting. Then "ON" will be display on the LCD screen of the remote control, at the same time, digital of time hour flashes, press or to set the time to turn the fireplace on. After setting the startup time, "OFF" will be displayed on the LCD screen and press or to set the shutdown time. When the shutdown time's set, "AUTO" will be displayed on the LCD screen of the remote control and the digital of temperature flashes. At this time, you can set the temperature by or . Now, you have finished setting of this function.

When the 7 day timer's set, the icon will be displayed on the LCD screen of the remote control. Press again to cancel the 7 day timer and the icon will disappears.

NOTE: If the 7 day timing and the general timing are set at the same time, the system will respond to an earlier shutdown time.

Press Refer button to check the settings of 7 day timer. Press or to see the settings of the day of the week and or the settings of the startup and shutdown time.

WIFI OPERATION

INSTALL TuyaSmart life

There are 2 ways to install TuyaSmart;

- 1. Search for "TuyaSmart life" in the APP store on your phone, download and install.
- 2. Scan the QR code below with your mobile phone.



WIFI SETTING AND FIREPLACE OPERATION

- 1. Create an account and log in.




FIG. 1 FIG. 2 FIG. 3

- 2. When you log in, touch "+" (FIG.1) to enter in FIG.2. Touch "others" on the left corner first and then choose "Connector (Wi-fi)" to enter in FIG.3 to set your Wi-fi account and password.




FIG.5 FIG.6 FIG.7

- 3. Press (flame button) on the touch panel of the fireplace for more than 5 seconds when the fireplace in standby mode. There will be 2 beeps come out from the fireplace and the (flame button) will flash as well indicating that Wi-fi is in EZ mode. Then please confirm to go next. (FIG.5)
- 4. The APP will scan (FIG.6) and add the fireplace to APP (FIG.7) automatically. Please make sure the Wi-fi account and password you set are correct and Wi-fi signal is good.
- 5. Touch "Done" to finish Wi-fi setting.(FIG.7)

6. Now you are in the interface like FIG.7. You can operate the fireplace via Wi-fi.




NOTE: Turn off the flashing blue Wifi indicator light



Touch the (power button) once, the blue light will stop flashing.


REPLACEMENT PARTS


