

Set up Headphones & Microphone

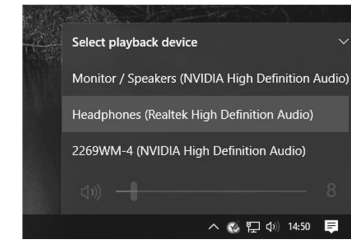
1. Make sure you have a headset with the correct cables. You need a Microphone jack and an Headphone jack to use on a PC. Some headphones also use a USB for power.



2. You can connect to the PC front or back ports. Green = Headphones Pink = Microphone



3. Right click the sound icon on the taskbar and make sure that your headset is set for playback.

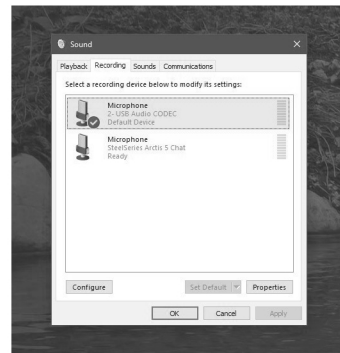


4. Right click the sound icon and open the sound settings on Playback. Make sure that your headphones are set to default. Right click and choose test - the green bar should go up and down.




If it doesn't make sure that your headset does not have a volume control anywhere on it.

5. On the sound settings choose Recording. Make sure your headphones are set to default. On the properties windows make sure that the levels are set to high.
