How to measure your ring size

DUEROS defines the ring sizes with the inner circumference of the ring in millimeter. For example, 60 mm correspond to size 60.



You can easily determine your own ring size with a self cut paper strip (width approx. 10 mm) or a measuring tape. To measure, simply place the paper strip (or tape) around the finger where you want to wear the ring later. Wrap the paper tightly around your finger. Mark the spot where the paper overlaps with a pen.



3. Measure the marked length of the paper strip using a ruler (or tape length) to get your ring size.



Select a size

If the measured size is between two ring sizes, please select the next larger size. For example: You measured a circumference of $61\,\mathrm{mm}$ then please select ring size 62.
