# Hello everyone and welcome to our latest Children of Kilimanjaro Orphanage newsletter.

So much has happened in the last year, and we are so excited to share the news with you. Finally, after looking at so many pieces of land we found the perfect piece to build our new orphanage.

Meanwhile our present home for COKO which we rent, is now getting to small

for us. We started with 5 children and are now up to 30.

The odds of finding a place to accommodate all the children and staff are very slim and with our lease up March 25th, 2025, we decided the best thing to do was to build our own new home.

We now own 1.6 beautiful acres in the Uru district of Moshi Tanzania right on Mount Kilimanjaro. Our land is loaded with fruit trees, and we will finally have lots of grass for the children to play on.

### CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS ON THE MOUNTAIN

Work has already started and as of today our land is cleared of all large trees and we have a 9' wall surrounding the land and are just waiting on all steel gates to be installed. Our new home will be able to house 48 children along with 8 full bath staff rooms, large storage shed, kitchen with pantry, large classroom, library and computer room and a separate volunteer/guest house with 8 more full bath rooms.

All of this is because of you supporting us from all over the world.
We couldn't of done this without you and your continued support.


### TRIP TO CHEMKA HOT SPRINGS
