You can use this guide with an existing ring to find out your ring size. Use a ring with a similar band width and style to the one (or more) you want to buy.

## OPTION 1 - MEASURE USING AN EXISTING RING

## STEP ONE

Print this document out to $100 \%$ - ensure the page scaling is set to 'none'. You can check it's accurate by measuring the line below. It should be exactly 5 cm .

## STEP TWO

Match the inside edge of your ring to the circle nearest in size.

## STEP THREE

The number that fits best within the circle, is your ring size. If your ideal size falls between two sizes, we recommend sizing up.

OPTION 2 - MEASURE USING STRING

## STEP ONE

Take a piece of string and wrap it around your chosen finger.

STEP TWO
Hold the string in place and mark the meeting point with a pen.

## STEP THREE

Use a ruler to measure the length of string to the marked point. Refer to the chart above the find your ring size.
