READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS: Failure to follow all the instructions may result in electrical shock.

The appliance is designed for domestic use and may only be operated in accordance with these instructions for use.

- When moving humidifier, lift the base and water tank together. **DO NOT** only lift water tank.
- **DO NOT** press the electric cord with heavy objects to prevent electric shock of fire hazards.
- **DO NOT** use damaged plug or electric cord to prevent fire hazards.
- **DO NOT** replace electric cord by yourself. If it is damaged, please contact a qualified technician to replace it.
- DO NOT unplug with wet hands to prevent electric shock or fire hazard.
- Shut down humidifier before detaching the water tank.
- **DO NOT** move humidifier when it is operating.
- If the base is not positioned on a flat and level surface, shut down humidifier and adjust its position to a level surface. **NEVER** place on a rug, carpet or finished floor.
- To prevent explosion or fire hazards, do not place humidifier near flammable areas.
- **DO NOT** place clothing or towels on top of humidifier. If the mist nozzle is covered or blocked, it may cause a malfunction.
- **DO NOT** place substances such as metal, chemicals or detergent into the reservoir, since this will cause poor atomization.
- **DO NOT** operate humidifier when there is no water inside the water tank.
- Use power voltage and frequency in accordance with the technical specifications.
- Connect power plug properly to prevent fire hazards.

CAUTION

- Only operate when fully assembled; only use as intended and described in this manual.
- Keep out of reach of small children.
- Always insert plug securely into the power source.
- Unplug the unit and empty the water tank and Base before carrying/moving.
- **NEVER** leave water in the reservoir when humidifier is not in use.
- Only unplug when the humidifier is turned off; ensure hands are dry.
- Always turn off the unit before removing, emptying or filling the water tank.
- Perform regular maintenance of the Ultrasonic Nebulizer; **NEVER** scrape Nebulizer with a hard or sharp object.
- \bullet Dry the unit completely before storage; store in a cool, dry place.
- **DO NOT** drop, hit or otherwise subject this product to excessive shock.

UNPACKING



Step 1

Carefully remove the humidifier from the box by pulling the base of the unit (**DO NOT** take the unit out of the box by pulling the tank up)



Step 2

Remove remote control from box.



Step 3

Remove the plastic bag from the humidifer.

WEEKLY CLEANING & CARE

WARNING: Before cleaning always turn power off and unplug the unit from the outlet.

WARNING: DO NOT rinse base under the faucet. To clean, wipe the base with a soft cloth.

WARNING: DO NOT use any solvents or aggressive cleaning agents. Keep water away from air outlet.

WARNING: DO NOT tamper with the water sensor.

The Following maintenance procedures must be routinely followed in order to ensure proper, efficient operation of your humidifier. The unit WILL NOT WORK CORRECTLY if it is not cleaned properly (Daily and weekly maintenance is recommended). Regular cleaning of the tank every three days can prevent the base and tank of scale deposition. It also prevents micro-organisms from growing in the base which ensures that




*To remove any scale or build-up in the Base or on the Ultrasonic Nebulizer, pour a 50/50 mixture of vinegar and lukewarm water onto the surface, then soak for five minutes. Note: Never submerge the base in water or any liquid.

About White Dust:

Use of high-mineral content water may cause a white mineral residue to accumulate on the roon surfaces near the humidifer. The mineral residue is commonly referred to as "White Dust". The higher the mineral content (the harder the water), the greater the potential for White Dust. The White Dust is not caused by a defect in the humidifier, but is due only to minerals suspended in the water from your tap.



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS





Note: Essential oils can be added directly into tank (Step 2).

STORAGE

- 1. Follow all cleaning instructions prior to storage.
- 2. Dry all parts, including the inside of the Water Tank.
- 3. Preferably store in its original box, in a dry place away from high temperatures.
- 4. Follow all cleaning instructions after long periods of storage.

- 1. Placement: Place humidifier on a flat surface.
- **2. Set Up:** Remove cover and pour clean water into the tank. Replace the cover and make sure it is in place (it can operate for over 24 hours when the tank is full of water.)
- **3. Turn on:** Connect to the power supply (120V /60Hz). Press power button, indicator light is on and humidifier starts to operate.
- 4. Operating Humidifier:

Power Button	Mist Output	Lights
1st press	High Mist	Power button turns bright white
2nd Press	Low Mist	Power button dims/50% mist
3rd Press	High Mist	7 colors/Power button bright
4th Press	Low Mist	7 colors/Power button dim/50% mist
5th Press	High Mist	Lights Off
6th Press	Low Mist	Lights Off
Long Press		Off

5. Auto Safety-Shut Off Function

When the water tank is low on water, the humidifier stops working and power button flashes a red light. This is to remind user to add water to the humidifer.

6. Operating Remote Control

- Power On/Off Press to turn on. Lights / Mist will be automatically set to high.
- Mist Setting Press once for low light and mist setting to 50%.
 - Press a second time and Lights/Mist will go back to high.
 - Press a third time to go back to low light and mist setting to 50%.
- **Light Control** Press to activate the 7 colors.
 - Press again to turn colored lights and power button ring off.
