Tips for the Jold'n Stitch Wreath

The Fold'n Stitch Wreath is a simple project - follow these *tips* for a faster finish!

- 1. This is not the pattern the following are tips that you can use <u>with</u> the purchased pattern. This tips page contains no fabric requirements, no cutting instructions, and no sewing instructions those are all in the purchased pattern.

- 5. Know which fabrics will appear where look at Figure 1 on your pattern.
- 6. Using a directional print for the appliques? You may want to cut them at 45° and position design carefully during assembly.
- 7. Before turning your squares to the right side, trim the corners at a diagonal to reduce bulk.
- 6. Use a walking foot or open-toe foot when appliqueing so you can see where you are going.
