## 27" BELOW GRADE INSTRUCTIONS

These instructions to the aboveground pool warranty are to cover corrosion when the pool is installed 27" in the gound. It does not cover structural damage due to improper installation procedures or frost heave. The conditions of our standard warranty are in full force when the pool is installed 27" in the ground if the following conditions are met: 1. The pool must be full prior to backfilling. 2. Proper backfill material must be used, such as sand or sifted soil with no rocks or sharp objects. 3. Neither the wall, the frame, nor any of the coatings must be damaged in the backfill process. 4. Backfill must be graded away from the pool 10 degrees. 5. The pool must be always kept 3/4 full of water at all times. If the pool must be drained at any time to service or repair the liner, it must be done during the dry season when the groundwater level is below the level of the pool bottom, so that the pool does not collapse inward. Any damage caused during the backfill operation or as the result of draining the pool will void the warranty. Swimming Pool Discounters will not be responsible for any inward collapse of the pool wall or frame under any circumstances. Swimming Pool Discounters will also not be responsible for any pool failure resulting from excessive water conditions such as flooding due to rainfall or other conditions.
