

Ring Size Guide

Ring sizes are measured by the internal diameter of the ring in millimetres.

The corresponding letter to millimetre measurement can be seen below.

If you are trying to determine your ring size, follow the below instructions:

1. Use a piece of string or dental floss and wrap it around the base of your finger, or measure the internal diameter of a ring you own and find the closest measurement in the chart below.
2. If you are using a string to measure your finger, use a pen to mark the point on the string where the end meets.
3. Use a millimeter ruler to measure the string
4. Choose the closest Ring Circumference measurement from the chart below to find your ring size.

TIPS

- Allow enough room to accommodate your knuckle.
- Measure the specific finger you are planning to wear the ring on.
- Keep in mind fingers may swell in hot and humid conditions.
- Thicker and wider bands may require a slightly larger size.
