

RING SIZING GUIDE - METHOD B AND C

IMPORTANT: Ensure you are printing at 100% when printing this page. Please follow instructions in the box to the right to confirm page has printed correctly.

TIPS:

- If purchasing ring as a surprise for someone, find another one of their rings and measure it using Method B.
- Different countries have different ring-size systems. All sizes listed here are American sizes.
- The average man's ring size is about 11. The average woman's ring size is about 6.
- Most people's dominant hand has slightly larger fingers. Make sure you measure the finger on the hand you want to wear the ring.

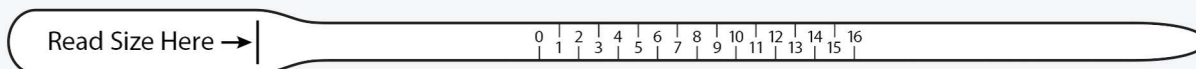
CONFIRM PRINTED SIZE

INSTRUCTIONS

Measure the above bar to ensure it has printed exactly 2 inches, or 50mm, long. If measurement is not accurate, ring size measurement will not be completed properly.

METHOD B - RING SIZING TOOL

1. Cut out the ring sizer below and make a small slit along the black line next to 'Read Size Here'.
2. Wrap the ring sizer snugly around the widest part of the intended finger so that the numbers are visible to you, and insert the pointed end through the slit you made in the sizer.
3. Make note of the number that lines up with the slit, this is your ring size!



METHOD C - COMPARISON CHART

1. Choose a ring that correctly fits the finger you are purchasing the ring for.
2. Lay the ring over each of the size circles below until you are able to closely match the inside edge of the ring to one of the circles on the guide. That is your size!
