



Frequently Asked Questions Regarding Train Movement

Can you skip over more than one of your own trains if they are on consecutive adjacent stops?

Yes, and it only costs one coal to do so!

If using a Whistle, you can do that, OR you can skip over any other stop and more than one of your own trains on consecutive stops

Can you skip over more than one *opponents'* trains if they are on consecutive adjacent stops using a Whistle?

No, Whistles only allow you to move two stops (you may skip over any one stop, regardless of if it has a train on it or not).

Is it possible to end up on the same space you started from?

Using a coal, you may travel along any number of consecutive track pieces that loop back to the starting tile, and end there, activating that tile again.

Using a whistle, you may travel along any number of consecutive track pieces OR any number of consecutive track pieces and one stop and then another set of consecutive track pieces that loop back to the starting tile, and end there, activating that tile again.

How is a Whistle different than a Coal?

A whistle allows you to make ONE or TWO consecutive coal moves (and it also lets you end up east of where you started as a bonus).
