$\mathrm{TOHO}^{\oplus}$ round seed beads and two colors of Matubo Ginkgo Leaf Beads are all you need to create this remarkable bracelet featuring TierraCast ${ }^{\oplus}$ Stitch-In Links.

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Unit 1: On 2 yd of thread, add the first hole of 1 link, $4 C$; pass through the second hole of the same link. Add A-Bottom to Top, 3C; pass through the open hole of the current A. Add C, A-Bottom to Top, C, A-Top to Bottom, C, A-Bottom to Top, 3C; pass through the open hole of the same A. Tie a knot against the tail to form a ring, leaving a 4" tail. Weave through to exit up through the open hole of the second A added in this step.
2. Unit 2: Add C, A-Bottom to Top, 3C; pass through the open hole of the current A. Add C, A-Bottom to Top, C, A-Top to Bottom, C, A-Bottom to Top, 3C; pass through the open hole of the current A. Add C; pass through the open hole of the nearest A of the previous unit. Add C; pass through the open hole of the next A of the previous unit. Weave through to exit up through the open hole of the second A added in this step.


Pay attention to which hole to use when adding or passing through Ginkgos.

| 2 | Jump Rings |
|  | Clasp of Choice |
|  | TOHO ${ }^{\circ}$ One-G Thread |

Units 3-11: Repeat Step 2 (Unit 2) nine more times for a total of 11 units; use B for the second and third Ginkgo Leaf Beads added in Unit 4 and in place of all A in Units 5-8.
3. Unit 12: Add C, A-Bottom to Top, 3C; pass through the open hole of the current A. Add the first hole of 1 link; the links are reversible, so make sure the link's pattern matches the first. Add 4C, the second hole of the same link, A-Bottom to Top, 3C; pass through the open hole of the current A. Add C; pass through the open hole of the nearest $A$ in the previous unit. Add $C$, pass through the open hole of the next $A$ in the previous unit. Weave through to exit the second 3C set added in this step.
4. Edging: Note: A shorter segment of the bracelet is shown for illustration clarity. a) Add 5C; skip over the tip of the nearest downward-pointing A and pass through the next C. Pass up through the left hole of the A just skipped and down through the right hole of the same A. b) Add 2C; pass through the third $C$ added in this step. Add 2 C ; pass through the next set of 3C on the bottom edge. Repeat from the beginning of this step ten more times. Weave through to exit the first 3C set of Unit 1.
Rotate the beadwork 180 degrees and repeat Step 4. Tie off. Use jump rings to attach the clasp to the links at each end.
