

The data is presented in several formats including a Business Directory, an Alphabetical Directory and a Street Directory. Also includes "Miscellaneous Information," mainly public services provided by local government but also entries for various religious and civic philanthropic organizations. Numerous advertisements throughout.

The Business Directory is divided by trades and professions.

The Alphabetical Directory appears to list ALL adults alphabetically by family name, giving their address, marital status, job or profession & property ownership. The names of deceased husbands is given in widows listings. Also listed in this section are businesses giving ownership / management data.

The Alphabetical Street Directory lists every property by location and shows the "head of household." Also an annotation indicating property ownership and presence of telephone. Location of Streets and crossings are also shown.

This is an exceptionally useful directory, especially considering that the census data will not be available for many years yet.

Although laid out to facilitate access we have configured this digital reproduction for computer text searches so that search terms not specifically indexed may also be found. Searching is enhanced by our FastFind technology for instantaneous results.
