



KOCHI COLLECTION

Each rug in the Kochi Collection has unique qualities. Every rug is truly one of a kind. The hand braided jute is woven in an ancient fashion which is prone to bowing and skewing. This creates an inconsistency in the linear 4" braid.

Natural jute fibers are generously woven in and may sprout where short ends are tied and tucked during the weaving process. Husks of the jute plant, which are coarse and darker in color, may be found within the weave. This nearly 1/2" thick material may inhibit movement of nearby doors. Variations in color are common to all natural fibers

Kochi is not suitable or recommended for broadloom installation when seaming is needed.

These natural characteristics of Kochi are embraced and even cherished as they undoubtedly display the hand crafted nature of every floor covering.

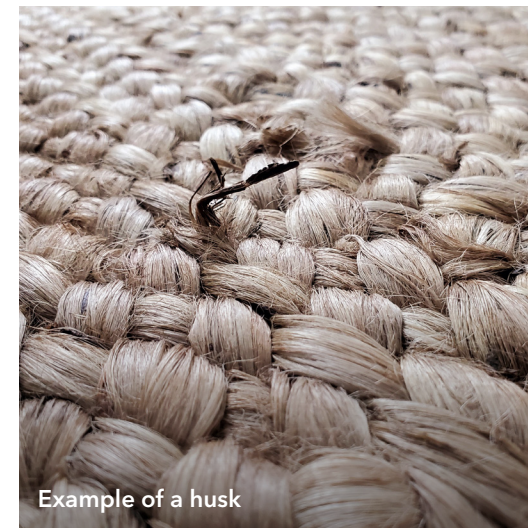
