Student Licenses

- A Student License costs MSRP US \$49.
- You must be a current student at an accredited educational institution to purchase.
- Student Licenses are valid for one year from the date of purchase, and include maintenance and support.
- The same Student License can be installed on both your desktop and laptop computers.

Educator Licenses

- You must be an educator at an accredited educational institution.
- You must also provide a current faculty ID, course syllabus, or other similar document.
- Educator Licenses are free SketchUp Pro licenses that expire.
- Educator Licenses expire one year from the date of generation, and include maintenance and support.
- The same Educator License can be installed on both your desktop and laptop computers.
- Educators may not share their licenses with students.

Networked Lab Licenses

Networked Lab License Pricing:

- License terms of one, two or three years are available, and version updates and upgrades are free.
- One-year licenses: US \$15 per seat (MSRP)
- Two-year licenses: US \$25 per seat (MSRP)
- Three-year licenses: US \$30 per seat (MSRP)
- Networked Lab Licenses are intended for installation on computers in a networked lab situation, and are floating network licenses.
- Networked Lab Licenses are only available to accredited educational institutions and not-for-profit organizations with instructional facilities for use in instructional settings.
- Networked Lab Licenses expire 1, 2, or 3 years from the date your license was generated, and include maintenance and support.
- Facilities/Planning departments within educational institutions do not qualify.

Institutional Laptop Program Licenses

Licensing for Image-Installed Laptop Networks

- A single license is issued for use on all laptops on the network.
- An image-installed Laptop License starts at MSRP US \$39 per seat and is discounted based on quantity.
- Laptop Licenses expire one year from the date of generation, and include maintenance and support.
- All laptops are configured from an operating system and software "master image" built by your IT department, your laptop vendor, etc.
- Users don't install software titles individually; everything is pre-installed on the laptops when they are given to students and faculty.

Licensing for non-image-installed laptops

- Multiple licenses are issued for use on individual laptops on the network.
- A non-image-installed batch Laptop License costs MSRP US \$39 per seat.
- Laptop Licenses expire one year from the date of generation, and include maintenance and support.
- Laptops are administered individually, either by users or by IT specialists in your facility.
- Laptops are not distributed with all software pre-installed; software is installed on a per-computer basis.

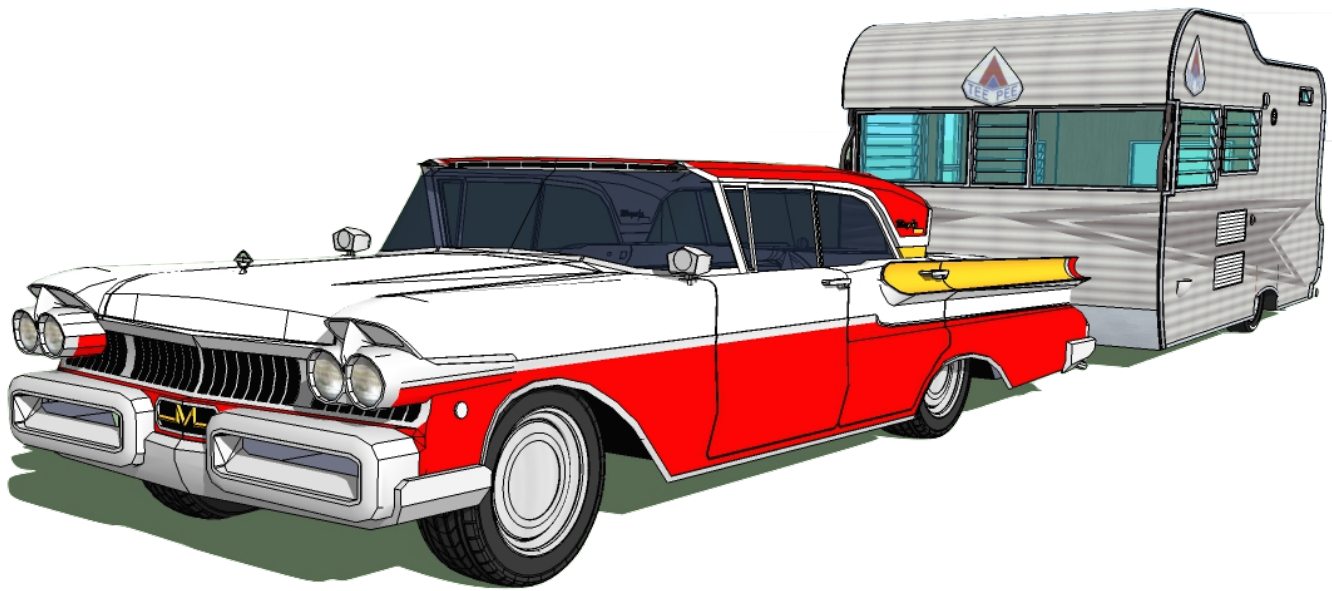

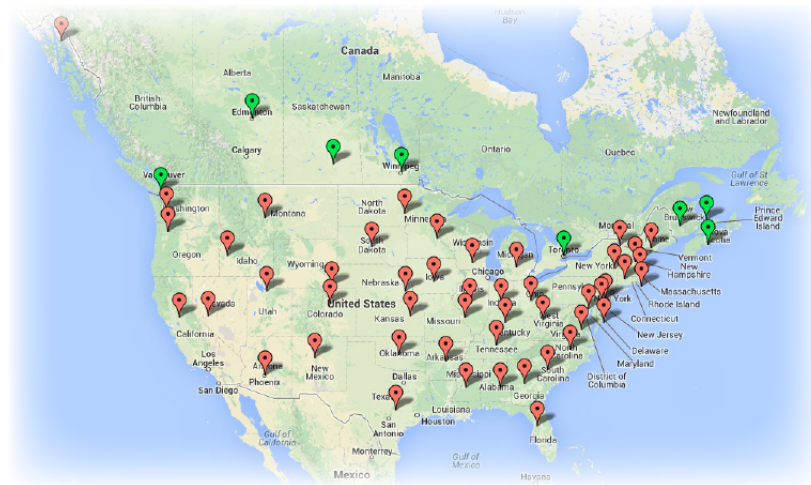
