We have been asked to provide our comments on the financial status of the Thankyou Charitable Trust as at 30 June 2013, specifically in relation to the net deficit position.

The Thankyou Charitable Trust is an income tax-exempt charity registered with the Australian Charities and Not-for-profit Commission. The Thankyou Charitable Trust's major asset is the ownership of 100% of the issued shares in the Thankyou Group Pty Ltd, a trading company registered with the Australian Investment and Securities Commission.

The Thankyou Charitable Trust has paid donations to its charitable partners as follows:

- 30 June 2013 \$414,581
- 30 June 2014 \$852,027

The Thankyou Charitable Trust has a deficiency in net assets of \$403,991, as at 30 June 2013. The net deficiency is a result of advances provided by the Thankyou Group Pty Ltd which have been used by the Thankyou Charitable Trust provide donations to charitable partners.

The Thankyou Group Pty Ltd declares franked dividends to the Thankyou Charitable Trust on an annual basis. The loans are intended to be cleared in future through the payment of fully franked dividends. It is expected that the deficit will be significantly reduced as at 30 June 2014.

Independent Auditor's Report

Thankyou Water Pty Ltd & Thankyou Charitable Trust

We have audited the financial reports of Thankyou Water Pty Ltd and Thankyou Charitable Trust for the financial year from 1 July 2012 to 30 June 2013. During this period the donation disbursements of Thankyou Water Pty Ltd & Thankyou Charitable Trust totalled \$141,000. The schedule of donation disbursements has been prepared by the Directors.

Director's Responsibility for the Schedule

The Directors are responsible for the preparation of the donation disbursement schedule and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of the schedule that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the schedule based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards. Those standards require that we comply with relevant ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the schedule is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the schedule. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgement, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the schedule, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the company's preparation of the schedule in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the company's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the schedule.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

Opinion

In our opinion, the donation disbursements of Thankyou Water Pty Ltd & Thankyou Charitable Trust for the financial years ended 30 June 2013, totalling \$141,000, is in all material respects in accordance with the audited financial reports for this period.

Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Distribution

Without modifying our opinion, we draw attention to the schedule as being prepared to assist Thankyou Water Pty Ltd & Thankyou Charitable Trust reporting requirements. As a result, the schedule may not be suitable for another purpose. Our report is intended solely for Thankyou Water Pty Ltd & Thankyou Charitable Trust and should not be distributed to parties other than Thankyou Water Pty Ltd & Thankyou Charitable Trust.

Notes to the Financial Statements

Thankyou Charitable Trust For the year ended 30 June 2013

1. Statement of Significant Accounting Policies

The trustees have prepared the financial statements of the trust on the basis that the trust is a non-reporting entity because there are no users dependent on general purpose financial statements. The financial statements are therefore special purpose financial statements that have been prepared in order to meet the requirements of the trust deed and the information needs of stakeholders. The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the significant accounting policies disclosed below, which the directors have determined are appropriate to meet the purposes of preparation. Such accounting policies are consistent with the previous period unless stated otherwise. The financial statements have been prepared on an accruals basis and are based on historical costs unless otherwise stated in the notes. The financial statements were authorised for issue on [Issue date: Δ] by the trustees.

Property, Plant and Equipment

Property, plant and equipment is initially recorded at the cost of acquisition or fair value less, if applicable, any accumulated depreciation and impairment losses. Plant and equipment that has been contributed at no cost, or for nominal cost, is valued and recognised at the fair value of the asset at the date it is acquired. The plant and equipment is reviewed annually by directors to ensure that the carrying amount is not in excess of the recoverable amount from these assets. The recoverable amount is assessed on the basis of the expected net cash flows that will be received from the utilisation of the assets and the subsequent disposal. The expected net cash flows have been discounted to their present values in estimating recoverable amounts.

Freehold land and buildings are measured at their fair value, based on periodic, but at least triennial, valuations by independent external valuers, less subsequent depreciation for buildings.

Increases in the carrying amount of land and buildings arising on revaluation are credited in equity to a revaluation surplus. Decreases against previous increases of the same asset are charged against fair value reserves in equity. All other decreases are charged to profit or loss.

Any accumulated depreciation at the date of revaluation is offset against the gross carrying amount of the asset and the net amount is restated to the revalued amount of the asset.

Intangibles

Goodwill is recognised as the excess of the purchase price for a business acquired over the fair value of the net assets at the date of acquisition. Goodwill is assessed for impairment annually and is carried at cost less accumulated impairment losses.

Trade and Other Receivables

Trade receivables and other receivables, including distributions receivable, are recognised at the nominal transaction value without taking into account the time value of money. If required a provision for doubtful debt has been created.

Financial Assets

Investments held are originally recognised at cost, which includes transaction costs. They are subsequently measured at fair value which is equivalent to their market bid price at the end of the reporting period. Movements in fair value are recognised through an equity reserve.

Trade and Other Payables

Trade and other payables represent the liabilities for goods and services received by the trust that remain unpaid at 30 June 2013. Trade payables are recognised at their transaction price. They are subject to normal credit terms and do not bear interest.

Provisions

Provisions are recognised when the trust has a legal or constructive obligation resulting from past events, for which it is probable that there will be an outflow of economic benefits and that outflow can be reliably measured. Provisions are measured using the best estimate available of the amounts required to settle the obligation at the end of the reporting period.

Notes to the Financial Statements

Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include cash on hand, deposits held on call with banks, other short-term highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less, and bank overdrafts.

Revenue Recognition

Revenue from the sale of goods is recognised upon the delivery of goods to customers. Revenue from the rendering of services is recognised upon the delivery of the services to customers. Revenue from commissions is recognised upon delivery of services to customers. Revenue from interest is recognised using the effective interest rate method. Revenue from dividends is recognised when the entity has a right to receive the dividend.
