The Farmer comes into the chicken coop after a few days and she sees 33 eggs were laid. How many were laid by Henrietta and how many were laid by Sally?

Days Henrietta only lays eggs: 3 eggs laid
Days Sally and Henrietta lays eggs: 8 eggs laid
Day 1: 33-8 = 25
Day 2: $25-3=22$
Day 3: $22-8=14$
Day 4: 14-3 = 11
Day 5: $11-8=3$
Day 6: 3-3 = 0
6 days x 3 eggs $=18$ eggs for Henrietta
6 days $/ 2=3$ days Sally lays eggs
3 days x 5 eggs $=15$ eggs for Sally
Henrietta: 18
Sally: 15
