# FRUIT TREE SPRAY PROGRAM

### **FALL & WINTER**

## Fall: After leaves drop

- 1. Best time to prune!
- 2. Spray with a combination of Horticulture Oil and Liquid Copper Mixed at a rate of 1 oz per gallon for control and cleanup of pest and diseases.

#### Late Winter: before buds crack

1. Spray with a combination of Horticulture Oil and Liquid Copper Mixed at a rate of 1 oz per gallon for control and cleanup of overwintering pest and diseases.



#### **EARLY SPRING: FULL BLOOM**

1. Spray Garden Phos at the rate of 1/2 oz per gallon for control of diseases such as Fire Blight and repeat every 4 weeks.

2. Spray Liquid Copper, 1 oz per gallon, and alternate with Monterey Complete Disease Control, 1 tsp per gallon, every 7 days until the blossoms drop.



#### **SPRING AND SUMMER**

1. After the petals drop, apply Fruit Tree Spray Plus, 1 oz per gallon, at 7-14 day intervals throughout growing season.

**2.** For heavy disease or fungus infestations alternate between Liquid Copper, 1 oz per gallon, and Complete Disease control, 1 oz per gallon, until under control.

**3.** For heavy infestations of insects and worms spray Garden Insect Spray, 2 oz per gallon, every 7 days until under control.

**TIP:** Remember to always spray early in the morning, late in the evening, or on a cloudy day to prevent burning.
