NICHOLAS HARDING

LONDON-BORN ARTIST NICHOLAS HARDING IS KNOWN FOR HIS THICKLY-LAYERED OIL PAINTINGS, WATERCOLOURS AND LARGE-SCALE INK DRAWINGS. FEATURING IMAGES OF BEAUTIFUL FLOWERS, GRITTY METROS AND AUSTRALIAN BEACHES, HARDING'S WORKS DEMONSTRATE A FASCINATION WITH LIFE AND NATURE, AND HIS TECHNICAL SKILL AS A DRAUGHTSMAN AND PAINTER.

A PREVIOUS WINNER OF THE ARCHIBALD PRIZE AND THE DOBELL DRAWING PRIZE, HARDING HAS HELD MANY SELL-OUT SOLO EXHIBITIONS AND HAS BEEN INCLUDED IN MAJOR EXHIBITIONS AT THE NATIONAL TRUST'S S.H. ERVIN GALLERY, THE NATIONAL PORTRAIT GALLERY AND THE ART GALLERY OF NEW SOUTH WALES. HIS WORK IS HELD IN AUSTRALIAN COLLECTIONS INCLUDING THE ART GALLERY OF NEW SOUTH WALES, THE NATIONAL GALLERY OF AUSTRALIA AND THE NATIONAL PORTRAIT GALLERY, AND IN PRIVATE AND CORPORATE COLLECTIONS IN AUSTRALIA, SINGAPORE, THE UK AND USA.
