Our Website <https://ro.steelcase.com/> uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our Website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our Website and also allows us to improve our Website. On revisiting our Website, we will therefore be able to obtain information about your previous visits and about your computer including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration and to report aggregate information for Steelcase marketing purposes.

We reserve the right to make changes to this Cookie policy at any time and for any reason by updating the “Last Updated” date at the top of this page. Any changes or modifications will be effective immediately upon posting the updated Cookie policy on the Website without sending a notice to you.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that are stored on your browser or the local drive of your device (computer, tablet or mobile phone) if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your device’s local drive. Generally, such a ‘cookie’ being a file in your web browser will enable a website to recognize your device when you visit it. These cookies contain information about you and your preferences. In this document, the term “Cookies” refers not only to files of this type, but also to technologies that perform a similar function (e.g., tags, web beacons, etc.).

The Cookies used on our Website can be classified in one of the following categories:

STRICTLY NECESSARY COOKIES: These are Cookies that are required for the operation of our Website. They include, for example, Cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our Website.

ANALYTICAL/PERFORMANCE COOKIES: They allow us to recognize and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our Website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

FUNCTIONALITY COOKIES: These are used to recognize you when you return to our Website. This enables us to personalize our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences.

TARGETING COOKIES: These Cookies record your visit to our Website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to

make our Website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

To comply with current legislation, we need to ask for your consent to set the Cookies described above. When you arrive on our Website, a message is displayed asking for your consent to place Cookies on your device as part of your navigation experience. If you, or another user of your computer, wish to withdraw your consent at any time, you can do so by altering your browser settings. The 'Help' feature on most browsers will tell you how to prevent your browser from accepting new Cookies, how to have the browser notify you when you receive a new Cookie, how to disable Cookies, and when Cookies will expire.

Cookies are essential in order to enable you to browse and use our Website and use its features, such as making pages load properly.

You can disable Cookies by changing your web browser settings. You can decide whether you want to allow such Cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some Cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all Cookies (including strictly necessary Cookies) or if you don't consent to strictly necessary Cookies you may not be able to access all or parts of our Website.
