Measuring for your clever closet rods

<u>Determine which closet rods will work for your application to do this you will need to consider the following.</u>

- 1.We provide three different lengths of closet rod arms.
 - One 32" will pass through a 36" opening.
 - One 27" will pass through a 30" opening.
 - One 22" will pass through a 24" opening.
- 2.We provide a Jamb bracket.
 - you'll need a minimum of 4 ¼" on the inside of your closet.
- 3. We have a mounting post that can be used instead of the jamb brackets.
 - The post can be used in 6' 8" to 7' high doors.
- 4. For use in a standard or greater than 24" deep closet or space.
 - When perpendicular arms are installed 12" of shelving may be applied behind the application at minimal loss to hanging space.
- 5. Proximity of arm rotation must be a consideration.
 - Any obstruction that impedes the operational rotation of the arms while bearing load such as (tables, chairs, tvs, or certain bifolding doors) the mounted post application might better serve your needs.
- 6. Determine desired height and spacing of closet rods considering hanger hook and width.
 - What height the clothes hang from the hangers.
 - How far apart the hangers need to be spaced Depending on the width.
 (spacing may vary depending on Size hook and width of the hangers.)
- 7. Weight of clothing Not to exceed 35 lbs.
