Sentry Wellness System Replacement Filters Contents (P/N: CP-SWS-FR):

- A) 1 Catalytic Carbon Filter
- B) 1 Trappsorb Drop-In Filter

Tools Needed (Not Included):

• Wrench included with the Sentry Wellness System

Verify you have the necessary components listed above before starting installation.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT REMOVE PLASTIC WRAP FROM FILTERS UNTIL INDICATED IN STEPS 3 & 4.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

STEP 1: Identify the cold water source by turning your faucet on to 100% cold and then shut off the cold water flow by turning the corresponding water valve clockwise. If your system is connected to your fridge rather than your sink, then turn off the cold water valve for your fridge.

This valve should remain off for the entire filter replacement process.

- **STEP 2:** Place a container for catching water beneath the Sentry Wellness System.
- **STEP 3:** Using the black wrench provided with your Sentry Wellness System, carefully untwist the Catalytic Carbon Housing from the system. Dispose of the water and used filter.

Remove plastic wrap from the Catalytic Carbon Filter and place into the Catalytic Carbon Housing. **IMPORTANT: The Catalytic Carbon Filter MUST be placed into the Catalytic Carbon Housing on the left side of the system.** Unwrap and install each filter one at a time to avoid mixing them up.

Twist the housing closed by hand until the label faces forward. **To prevent leaks, DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN—hand tightening creates the most effective seal.**













STEP 4: Using the black wrench provided with your Sentry Wellness System, carefully untwist the Trappsorb Housing from the system. Dispose of the water and used filter.

Remove plastic wrap from the Trappsorb Drop-In Filter and place into the Trappsorb Housing. **IMPORTANT: The Trappsorb Drop-In Filter MUST be placed into the Trappsorb Housing on the right side of the system.**

Twist the housing closed by hand until the label faces forward. **To prevent leaks, DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN—hand tightening creates the most effective seal.**

STEP 5: Restore the cold water flow by turning the cold water valve counter-clockwise with your faucet on. If your system is connected to your fridge, then simply turn the cold water valve for your fridge back on.

Check for leaks at the fitting locations or housing gasket locations. If there is a leak, either the tubes need to be pushed in further or the housings need to be reset via Steps 3 & 4. We recommend checking at this point and then again once you turn off your faucet. Continue to monitor for 1 week.

STEP 6: Run the cold water (or fridge water if applicable) for 5-10 minutes to purge the system of excess carbon and trappsorb dust. If water appears cloudy and doesn't taste sweet, continue to purge the system for another 5 minutes.

As the system normalizes, you may notice reduced water pressure for up to 1 week. If you're experiencing significantly reduced water flow, flush the filters by switching back and forth between hot and cold water at the faucet for up to 5 minutes.

STEP 7: Replace filters annually and enjoy your deliciously clean water!
