THELMA Visual Artists (TVA) is a professional group of artists devoted to promoting and encouraging visual art throughout Fond du Lac and the surrounding areas. As a program of Thelma Sadoff Center for the Arts, TVA fosters creativity and focuses on professional development through a supportive artist community, exhibitions, classes, workshops and collaboration.



The **Fond du Lac Children's Chorale** is a community children's chorus comprised of fourth through eighth grade students, from Fond du Lac area and surrounding communities, interested in performing and studying high-quality choral music. Founded in 1997 as a project of the Fond du Lac Arts Council, it is a resident ensemble of THELMA. The Chorale performs two major concerts each season, in addition to smaller appearances at other venues throughout the year. The Chorale's repertoire provides an enjoyable and challenging musical experience, while expanding children's learning horizons in music fundamentals, vocal technique and rehearsal discipline. Musicianship and artistry are taught in rehearsals through a performance-based music education process that aims to inspire appreciation and enjoyment of music, while developing personal and artistic excellence, and enriching our community. Auditions are held at various times throughout the year and by appointment. This program is for any child who loves to sing! The Children's Chorale is an organization where children are encouraged to express themselves.

The **Lake Reading Series** hosts writers at THELMA, providing opportunities for community members, students, creative writers, and book-lovers to engage with contemporary literature and authors writing today – from poets, to novelists, to memoirists. Also, join the **THELMA Book Club** once a month on Monday evenings! It's free and open to the public!

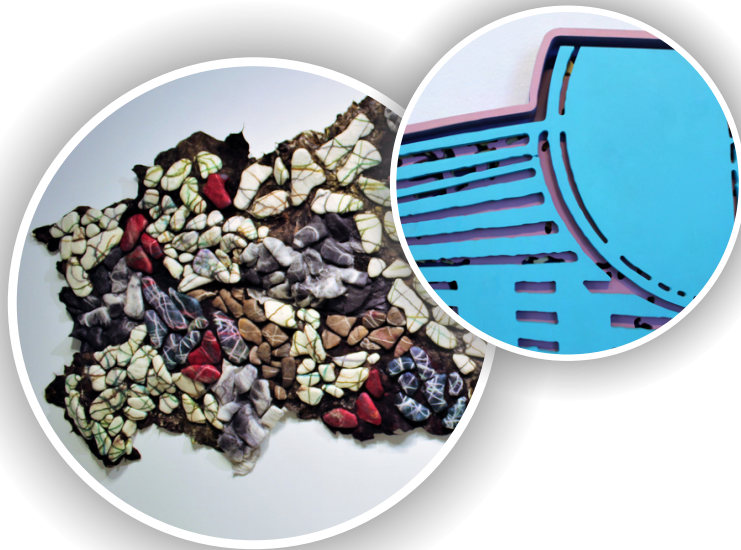
On Stage @ THELMA is a children's theatrical program ran in the summer months. This year, On Stage @ THELMA chose "BOTS!" as their theatrical adventure, the story of a BOTS Robotics Competition where teams and their (singing and dancing) robots are all vying for the top prize! Fourth through eighth grade students learned the lines, the music, the dances, and built the sets in a two week adventure. Then on the final day, students performed!

A WAMI nominee for Best Big Band, THELMA is excited to have **Lighthouse Big Band** as their resident band. The 17-piece band attracts top-notch musicians from throughout East Central Wisconsin. The LBB performs music including traditional big bands/dance bands of the 30's and 40's, the music of Count Basie and Duke Ellington, Latin Jazz, and the more modern big bands like Gordon Goodwin's Big Phat Band, as well as big band versions of rock/fusion music. You can find LBB playing at THELMA on the second and fourth Tuesday of each month, starting at 7pm.

New to THELMA, The **Valley Jazz Institute** is a fully immersive jazz education program, teaching confidence and creativity through jazz education and providing exciting on-stage experiences for our students of all ages. The Valley Jazz Institute's flagship program is "**Students' Jam!**" – a jazz JAM session geared towards the opportunity of sharing musical ideas in a real world performance situation. Area high school players, as well as other local musicians of all ages, are invited to join the members of the WAMI award winning Jazz Orgy and noted jazz educator and performer Brad Curran for these authentic jazz JAM sessions at THELMA!



You will not only reflect upon art at THELMA but also connect directly with the artists who created it through informal artist exchanges, receptions, special events, and more. Visitors can find inspiration when visiting our **Susan O. Ahern Contemporary Wing**, home of 2 beautiful gallery spaces which host artists from both near and far. In 2022, THELMA hosted 14 various art exhibitions including Art Spectacular during Sturgeon Spectacular, our first ever Plein Air Competition, and our annual THELMA Visual Artists show. Exhibitions change out every 6 weeks with 2 new shows on each floor. Enjoy the abundance of natural light in this contemporary space as you wonder and take in the beauty of the original works of art! Whatever time of the year you choose to visit, there will be a new, unique series of exhibitions on display. 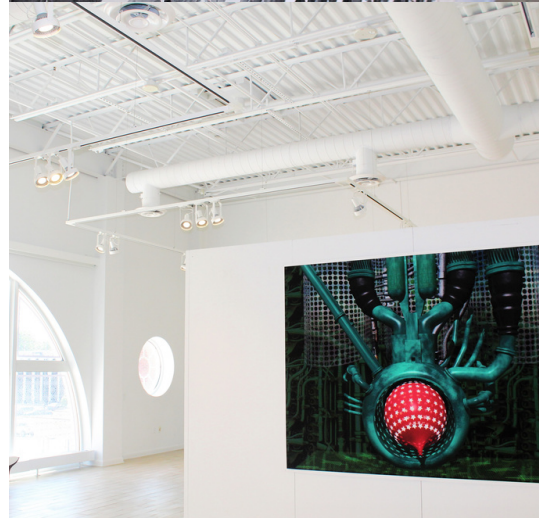

In 2022, THELMA offered over 30 various **Adult Classes**, ranging from sip n' paints to charcoal drawing for beginners, figure drawing to watercolor painting, and collage to plein air painting. Our offerings allowed all of our supporters to find something they could enjoy! With THELMA's adult art classes, all materials are provided and class sizes is limited to allow a comfortable, hands-on atmosphere. Most classes are also open to all ability levels. We also launched exciting new programs including monthly Women's Art History lecture, Mocktail Monday Sip n' Paints, and various community outreach programs fit to the specific organization's needs.



Studio 51 classes are designed to provide students of all ages with inventive art instruction through a creative and stimulating environment that expands their imagination and sense of self. Students will experience art in a direct, focused and encouraging atmosphere while creating unique artworks that they can share with the rest of the world. For these classes, children under 8 must be accompanied by an adult or a sibling over the age of 12. We had non-stop fun in our Studio 51 classes this past year! We introduced lots of new programming for the kids and created themed workshop for various holidays and events. The kids used their full imagination as they explored their creativity and made wonderfully unique artworks!

2022 was my first year as THELMA's new Arts Educator! This was an exciting year for Art Education. We made many new friendships in the Fond du Lac community. Children explored, grew self-confidence & resilience through creativity in our classroom. Our monthly class with the Senior Center reached max capacity, as we investigated traditional charcoal drawing techniques. Clients at the Arc were exposed to a new sensory world, as we painted with Saranwrap. Many fun nights were had at our paint and sips!

In 2023, Thelma is continuing our community partnerships to offer free classes to organizations in Fond du Lac. Kid's Club art classes are held every other Saturday at Thelma. We also offer a large range of Adult classes during the days and evenings. In addition to our regular paint and sips, we have introduced Mocktail Mondays! This is an NA opportunity for a night out on the town with art at the center. Thelma's Women's Art History Lecture has debuted as a success with lectures every month- A can't miss!

Regardless of age, ability, or skill level; you are welcome at Thelma. There is a place for art in your life, and a class is a wonderful place to start. The act of creating is more important than the result. I cannot wait to see you at our next class!

Collaborating with the Downtown FDL Night Markets, we enjoyed an entire downtown party every Thursday night!

Our programming continues to grow and we look forward to reaching more organizations in the coming 2023 year.

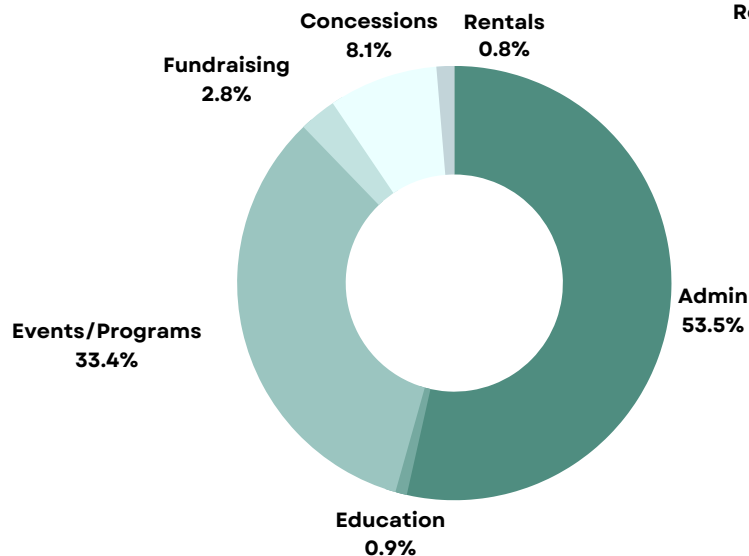

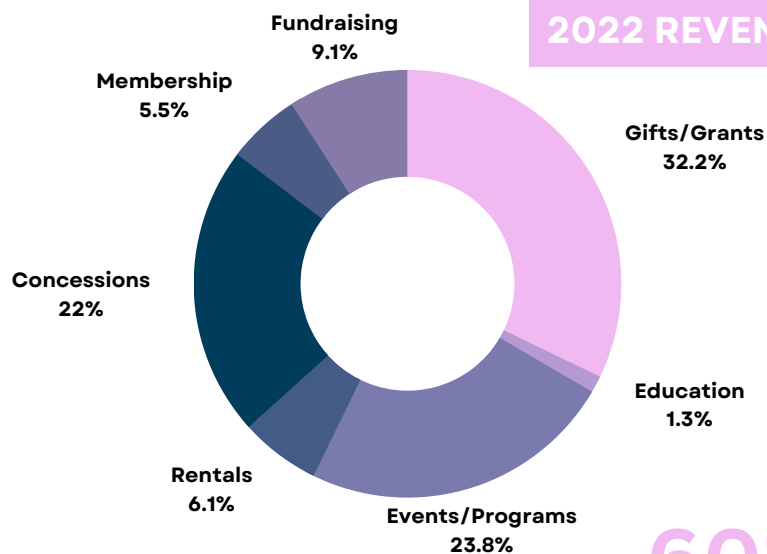

2022 EXPENSES

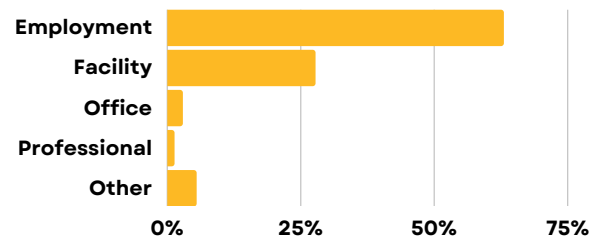


2022 REVENUE
