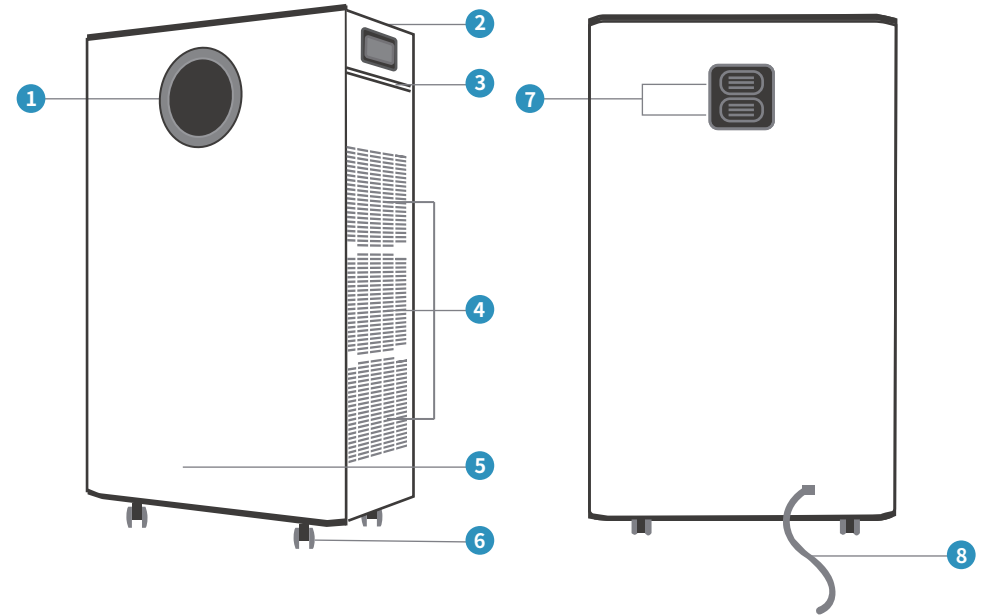
### CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

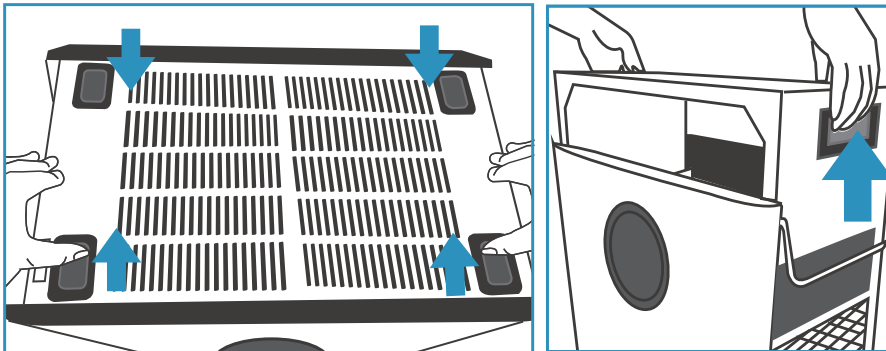

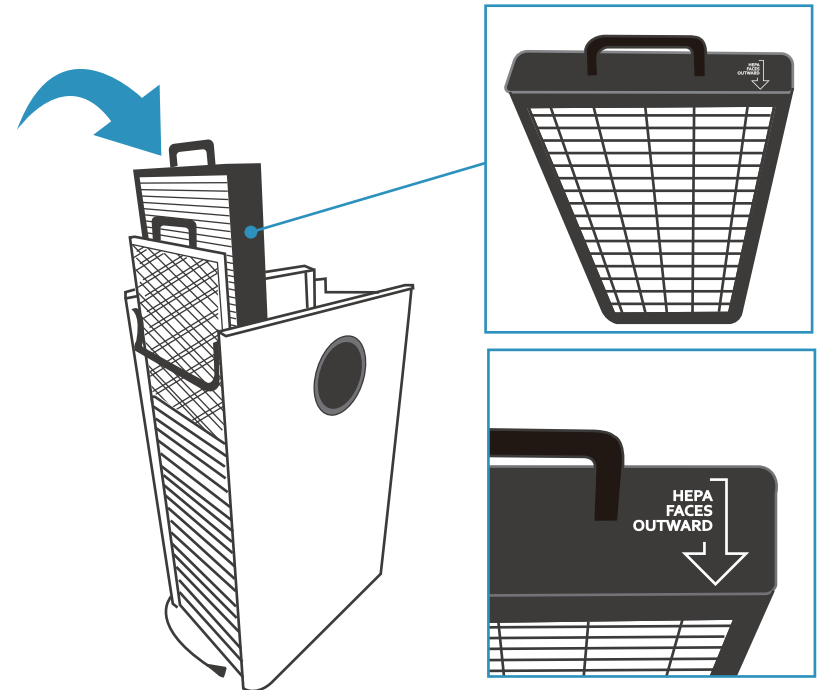
### INSTALLATION

1. Find an ideal location to maximize the air cleaning efficiency. The location should be farthest away from the room's HVAC return vent, windows, and doorways.
2. Place the purifier on a flat, stable surface. Allow at least 4" of clearance on all sides of the purifier. Keep away from anything that would block airflow.
3. Locate the closest electrical outlet.
4. Before turning on the unit, remove the top cover by sliding the four locking tabs on the top of the unit.



5. Remove the plastic packaging from the air filters located inside the air purifier unit before turning on or operating the unit.

6. After the plastic packaging is removed, insert both sets of filters into the unit. On each side, the Pre-Filter is inserted in the slot toward the outside of the machine, and the 3-Stage HEPA Filter is placed closest to the inside of the unit. The white HEPA portion of the 3-Stage HEPA Filter faces outward.



7. Plug the power cord into an electrical outlet.
8. Press the power button to turn on the unit. The unit will enter Auto Mode with Plasma and UVC Lamp on.

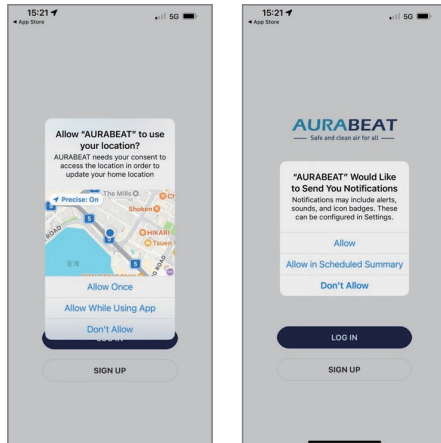


## SETTING UP THE APP

1. Scan the QR code to download the AURABEAT app from the App Store or Google Play. Once the app has been successfully installed, you can pair the unit.



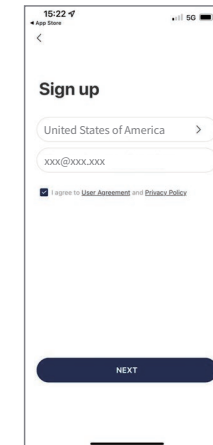
2. Press “Don't Allow” if you don't want to share your location or receive notifications.



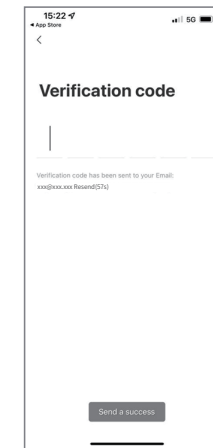
3. Press “Sign Up” to create an AURABEAT account.



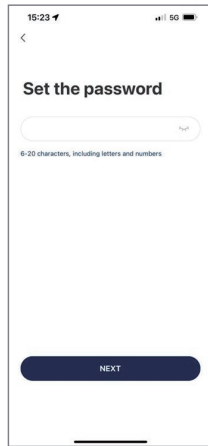

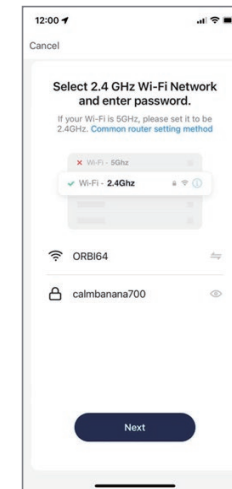


## PAIR THE DEVICE

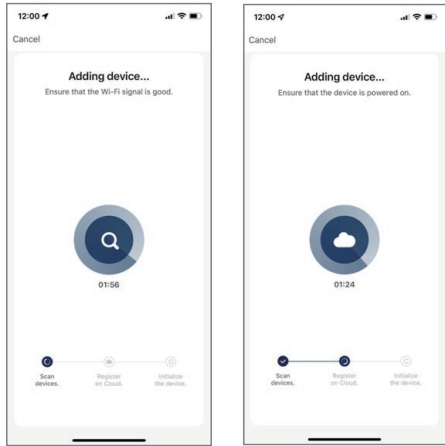
- Press the “+” at the top right corner to add device and press “Air Purifier (Wi-Fi)” under “Add Manually.”



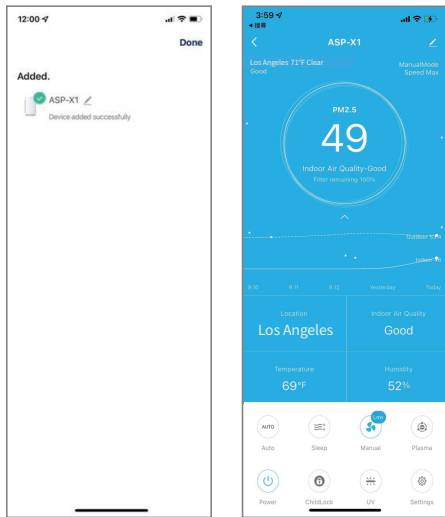
- Select a 2.4 GHz Wi-Fi network and enter the password of the Wi-Fi network. Press and hold the unit's Wi-Fi icon on the Touch Display for 5 seconds or until the icon begins blinking to activate the pairing mode.



- Click "Next" to enter the network configuration page. If the app is not activated successfully within 2 minutes, please deactivate the Wi-Fi function by pressing the "Wi-Fi" icon on the unit and repeat step 2 and 3 again for the app's connection.

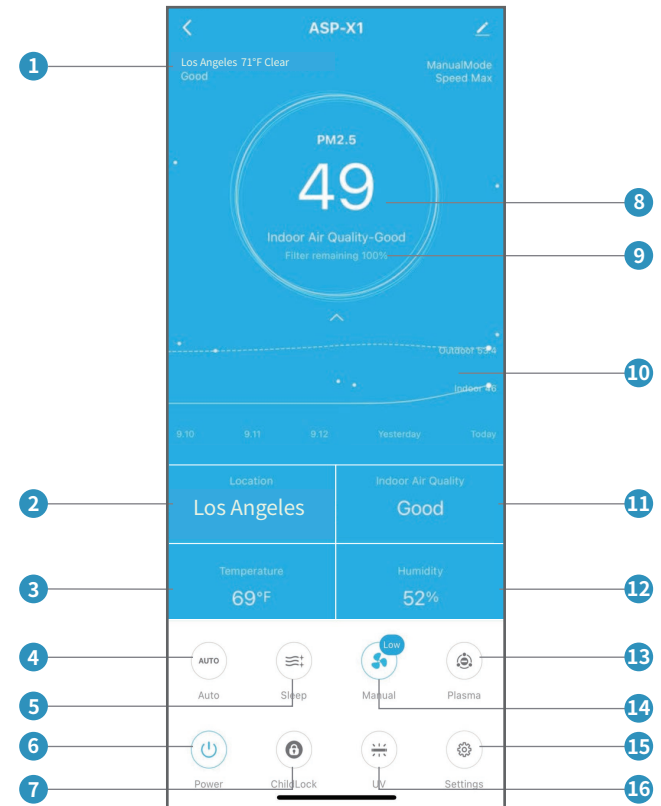


- After the network is successfully configured, click "Done" to enter the Main Page for the device operation.



- The first account paired with the device will be the owner. The owner can add members to the account to allow other AURABEAT app users to control the device.
- To change the owner of the device, follow instructions to reset the device on P. 22.

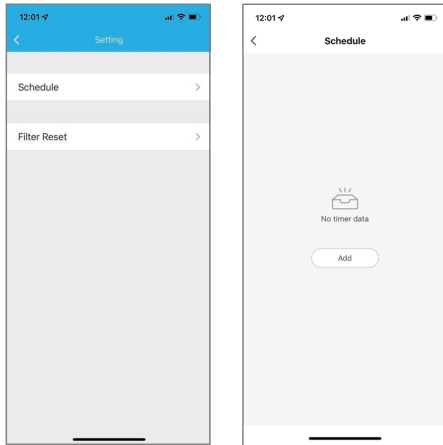

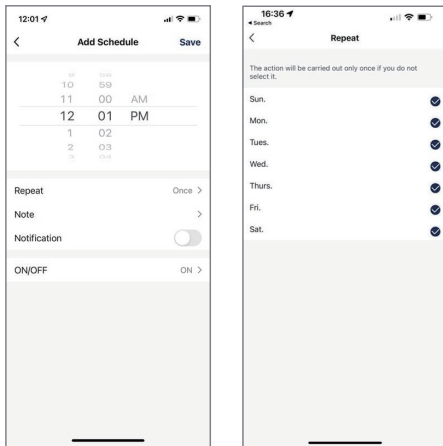

## SCHEDULE

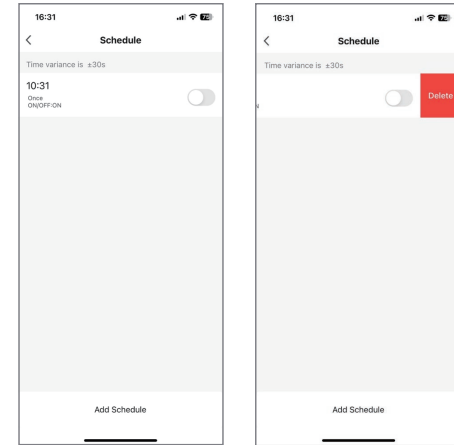
1. Press “Settings” and then press “Add” to add schedule in “Schedule.”



2. The schedule can be set for a maximum of 23 hours and 59 minutes and repeat by selected days of the week. The schedule “ON/OFF” function can only be set when the product is on. Press “ON/OFF” and select “ON” if you would like to schedule the device to turn on, select “OFF” if you would like to schedule the device to turn off.

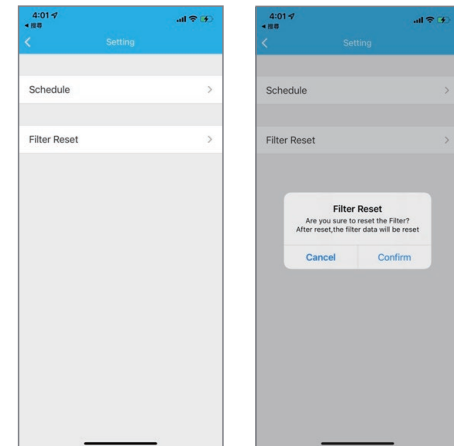


3. To remove a schedule, swipe left on the desired schedule then press “Delete.”

## 5. AIR PURIFYING FUNCTIONS

1. Pre-Filter: Captures hair, fiber, large particles, dander, etc., can be vacuumed and reused.
2. High Efficiency Air Filter: H13 HEPA Grade filter filters  $\geq 99.97\%$  of airborne particles 0.3 microns in size. It has low penetration, large capacity for holding dust, high clean air delivery rate can filter smoke and dust, especially for PM2.5, efficiently filtering particles down to  $\leq 0.01\mu\text{m}$ .
3. Activated Carbon Filter: Removes odors, VOC's, harmful gases and smoke.
4. Photocatalytic Oxidation Filter (PCO): Acting with UVC light, converts microorganisms, smoke, odors, VOC's, and chemically active compounds (CAC's) into water, carbon dioxide.
5. UVC Light: UVC lamp helps to sanitize the air, surface of the filters and the inside of the unit.

6. Plasma Purification: The positive and negative ions generated by the plasma generator neutralize in the air and produce huge energy, which results in the change of the microorganism structure around or the conversion of energy, thereby destroying the microorganisms. As the number of negative ions is greater than that of positive ions, excess negative ions are still floating in the air, which can remove smoke, dust, odors and improve air quality and health.

## 6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

### NOTE

- Never immerse the device in water or any other liquid.

### EXTERIOR

- Unplug device before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior of the air purifier with a soft, dry cloth. If necessary, wipe the housing with a damp cloth then dry immediately.
- Do not use abrasive chemicals when cleaning the air purifier.

### CLEANING AND REPLACING THE FILTERS

- For optimal performance, adhere to the recommended filter cleaning schedule.
- Always unplug the unit before opening the filter cabinet.

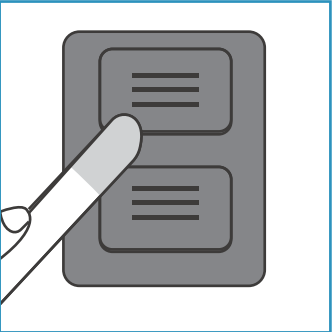
## AIR QUALITY SENSOR

Clean the PM2.5 Sensor every 2 months using the following method:

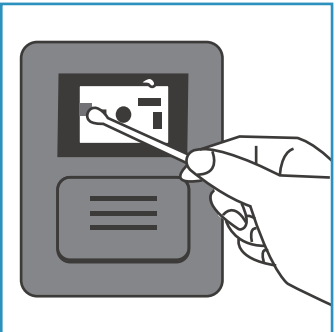
1. Open PM2.5 Sensor cover.



2. If there is dust around the sensor area, a vacuum hose attachment may be used to remove the dust.



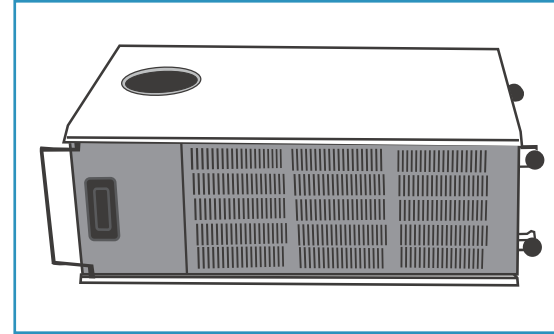
3. Wipe the lens with a dry cotton swab.



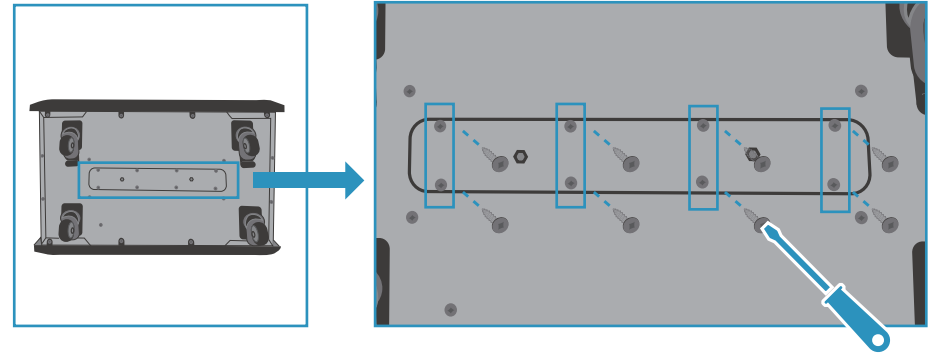
## UVC LAMP REPLACEMENT

Replace the UVC lamp when it burns out using the following method:

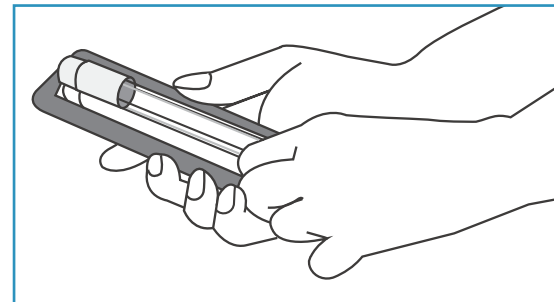
1. Unplug the unit and lay it on its side.



2. Remove the 8 screws from the panel located at the bottom.



3. Remove the old lamp and replace it.

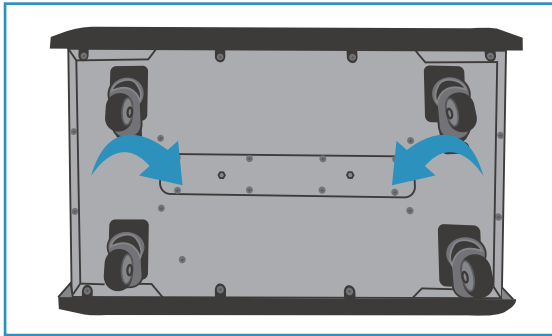
