NSP-X1 Air Purifier Quick Start Guide

For optimal results, it is essential to utilize all five filtration features and ensure proper placement within your space.



Getting Started

1. Remove the plastic packaging from the air filters inside the machine before operating the Aurabeat Air Purifier.
2. Once the plastic is removed, return the Nanocrystalline filter into the Aurabeat Air Purifier first, followed by the High-efficiency HEPA Grade Filter with the Pre-Filter facing toward the front. Next, close the front panel.
3. Plug the power cord into the back of the air purifier. Then, insert the power cord into an electrical outlet.
4. Press the on/off button, then press the Plasma button. The UV Disinfection Lamp will turn on automatically.

Note: *Once powered on, you will need to activate the Plasma feature on the Control Panel for optimal results. This setting is not saved when the unit is turned off.*

Aurabeat NSP-X1 Air Purifier Placement & Room Ventilation

Placement for Commercial Spaces or Residences With Mechanical Ventilation Systems

Place the Aurabeat Air Purifier near the room's air inlet. This allows the sanitized air to follow the natural air inlet flow pattern throughout the system. Do not place the Aurabeat Air Purifier near the air outlet vents, as this may hinder performance.

Placement for Residences or Commercial Spaces Without Mechanical Systems:

Place the Aurabeat Air Purifier in high traffic areas. Opening a window or door in the room will increase the clean air exchange rate within the space.

Filter Maintenance Schedule

Adhere to the maintenance schedule for the machine and the filters. The Owner's Manual contains comprehensive cleaning instructions, including a cleaning schedule. Air purifiers and filters are at their best when they are properly maintained.

PRECAUTIONS

— WARNING —



Disassembly is not allowed. To avoid danger, do not disassemble, modify or repair the product if you are not a qualified technician.



To avoid electric shock or damage, keep foreign objects away from the air inlet and outlet.



Do not use extension cords, multiple sockets or unauthorized adapters.



Always unplug the air purifier before cleaning or maintenance to avoid hazard or risk of electric shock.



This product is not intended to be operated by means of an external switching device, separate remote control system or improper power supply.



To avoid electric shock, do not touch the product and electrical plug with a wet hand.



The electrical plug must be plugged in all the way. Exposed plug prongs could result in fire hazards due to overheating. Do not use a damaged plug, power cord or a loose electrical outlet.



To prevent short circuit and electric shock, do not immerse or spray water or other liquids to the product.



Do not use the appliance in wet or highly humid surroundings such as the bathroom to prevent electricity leakage, electric shock and fire hazards.



Do not use in places with oily residues, smoke, or fumes, such as the kitchen to prevent damage to the product. The appliance cannot be used as an exhaust fan.



Do not use the appliance and ventilate the room after using spray insecticides or chemical to prevent chemicals from accumulating inside the machine and affect your health.



When used in the same space with combustion devices, make sure the room is well-ventilated to prevent carbon monoxide poisoning as the appliance does not remove carbon monoxide.



Do not use alcohol, organic solvents or abrasive cleaners or metal scrapers to clean any part of the appliance to prevent damage to the product, electric shock, fire hazards, etc.



Unplug the appliance by pulling the plug but not the cord to prevent damage to the cord, short circuit, electric shock, fire hazards, etc.



Do not use the appliance near fire or combustible materials.



Close doors and windows for efficient and rapid air cleaning.

NOTE

Unplug immediately and call service team if below situations occur:

- The control panel is not responding
- Short circuit happens
- The electrical cord or plug becomes very hot
- A burnt smell, unusual sound or vibration is observed
- Anything unusual or failures occur

Note: If the power cord or product is damaged, please call service team for maintenance or replacement.
