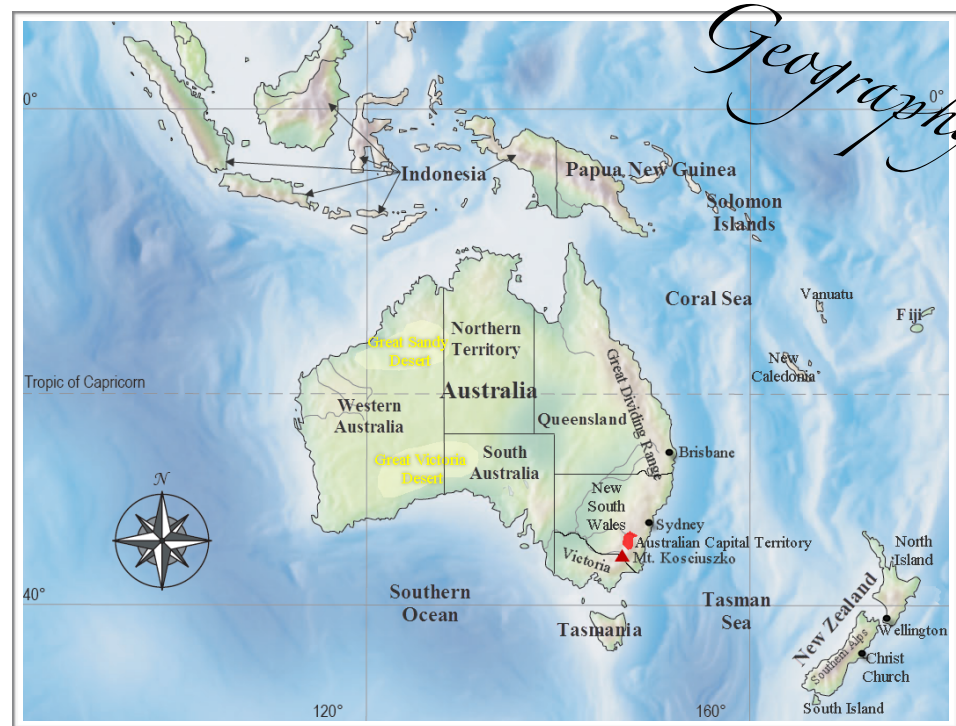
Tell me about Frankish Kings
