



Step 1 Use Jeep Wrangler hardtop screws and nuts* on the tub edge to mount the 6 provided Tie-down D-rings.


* The screws and nuts kit are not included to this package. They may or may not came with your Jeep Wrangler purchase.





Step 2 Guide the strap ends through the Tie-down D-rings with the GPCA cover logo side up.
