

What is your favorite toy to play with during bath time?


Lead a discussion with this question and ask follow-up questions:

Make the Bathtub a Fun Place

Do the children like coloring on the walls? Let them paint in the bathtub!

With fun kid-friendly watercolor paints, kids can enjoy painting on the ceramic tiles or porcelain tub, showing off their creativity while they get clean. Once they're ready to get out of the bathtub, show them how they can splash the paint away.

A Future Fisherman?

Find out during bath time! Drop some alphabet magnets in the tub, and hand your child a fishing pole with a magnet tied to the end. Let them catch as many letters as they can! Add an extra challenge and see if they can spell a word with the letters they catch.
