
The Art of **Jazz**

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Alyn Shipton is an award-winning author and broadcaster who presents jazz programs for BBC radio and was the jazz critic of the *Times* in London for over twenty years. He was consultant editor of the *New Grove Dictionary of Jazz*, and his own monumental *New History of Jazz* has won awards on both sides of the Atlantic, including the Jazz Journalists' Association Book of the Year. He was on the editorial board for *Jazz*: *The Smithsonian Anthology*, the acclaimed 2010 revision of this classic work. He has written several biographies of musicians; his book on singer-songwriter Harry Nilsson won a 2014 ASCAP Virgil Thomson/Deems Taylor Award for excellence in pop music writing. He is currently a jazz research fellow at the Royal Academy of Music in London, and lives in Oxford, UK.

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
