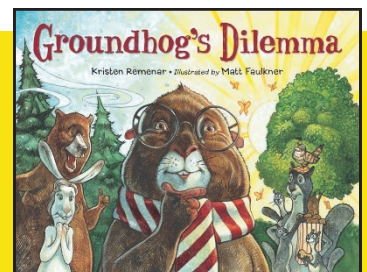




Whose shadow is whose?

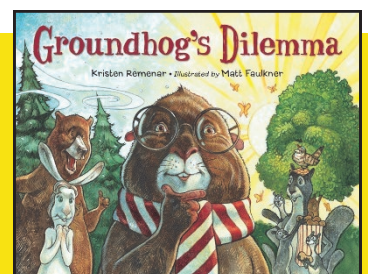
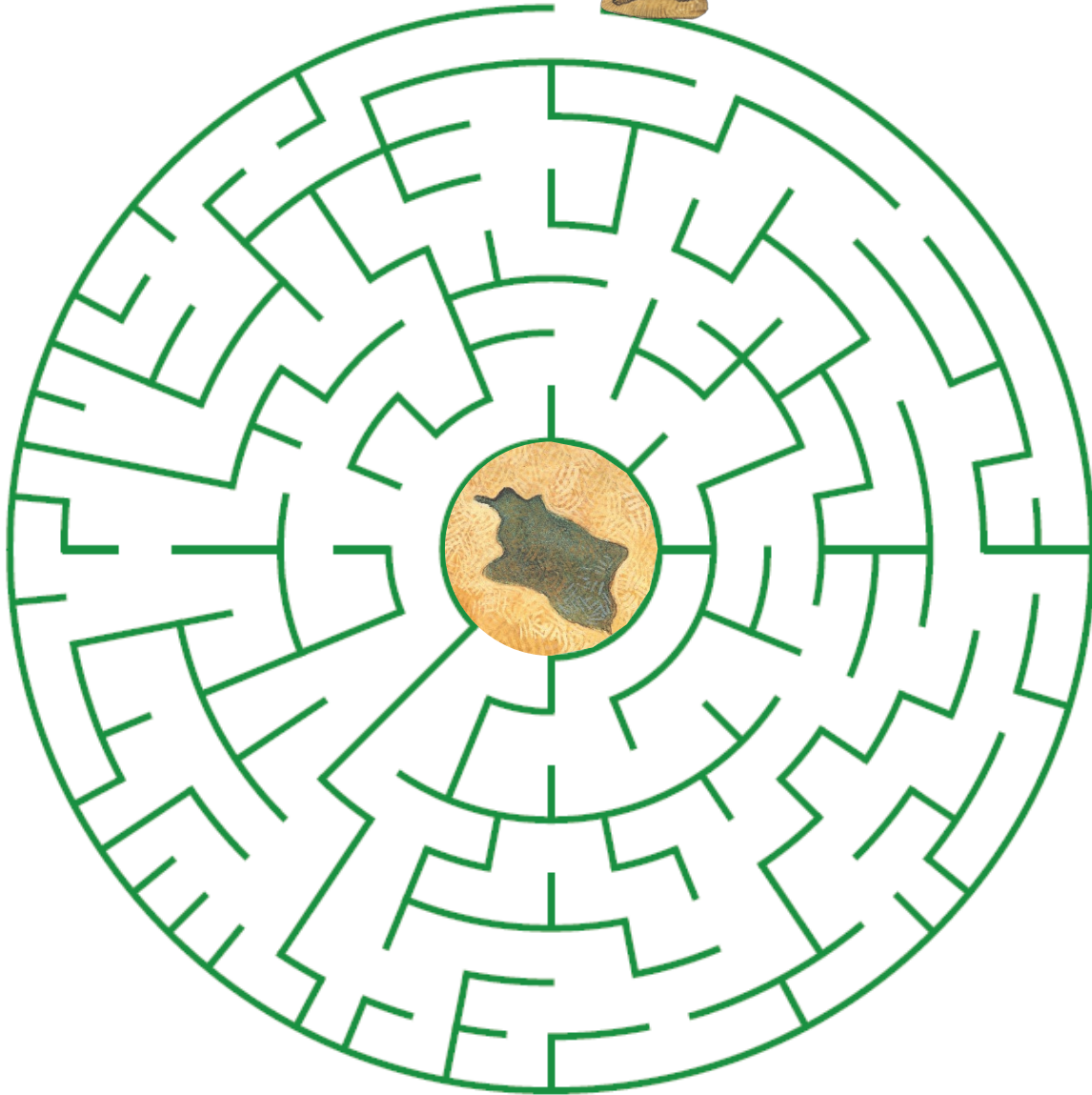
Match Groundhog and his friends with their shadows.

Groundhog's got a lot on his mind what with predicting the weather and trying to please his friends. Can you help him sort his thoughts?

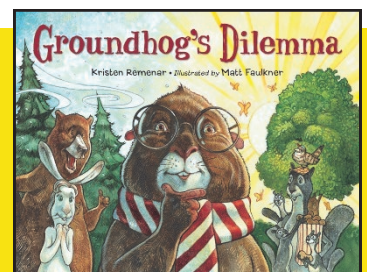
