THE ONLY DISTILLERY IN THE WORLD WITH ST ANDREWS IN ITS NAME

Founded in 2012, Eden Mill brought the lost art of distilling back to the area of St Andrews. A site rich with history, the whisky stories around this area date back to the late 1700s. All distillation ceased towards the end of the 1800s and it lay still for over 150 years until we began distilling single malt and gin and revived this lost art.

Our brand-new distillery, with its three distinctive black peaks that can be spotted from the 9th hole of the Old Course, will become operational later this year. We will continue to distil our premium spirits and can't wait to become an exciting new attraction in this iconic town.



A UNIQUE WHISKY PROFILE

Officially, we are a Lowland whisky by definition. However, our Head Distiller, Scott Ferguson, sums us up as a “Lowland whisky with a Highland heart” which we think is the perfect way to describe our unique spirit.

It showcases the floral, grassy notes more commonly associated with the Lowlands, but it also has some of the more full-bodied, sweet cereal notes that are typical of the Highlands.

This is the type of spirit we will continue to distil in our new home once it opens.

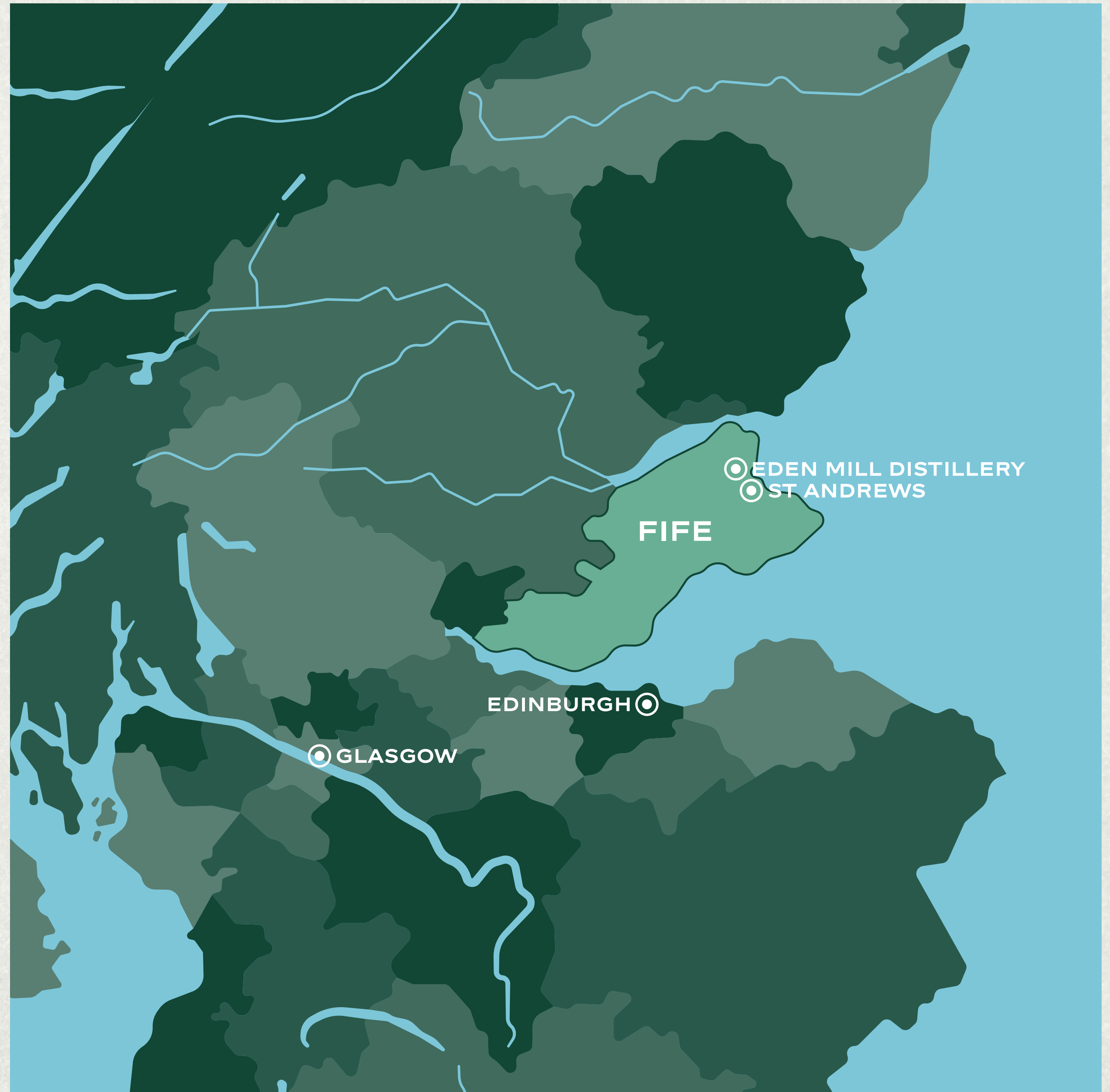


SCOTLAND'S NEWEST WHISKY REGION

Our home is in the Kingdom of Fife on the East Coast of Scotland. In recent years, there has been a small whisky revolution taking place here which has seen it start to become a whisky-making region in its own right.

Many more tourists are now coming to the area specifically to visit distilleries alongside their trips to more established whisky regions like Speyside and Islay.

We know that our new visitor centre will attract even more people through its doors once they open in early 2025 and we are excited about seeing Fife become increasingly celebrated for its single malt production.



PROGRESSING SUSTAINABLY

Our new distillery has a unique location on the University of St Andrews Eden Campus. This site is dedicated to sustainable business practice and research, and this is at the front of our minds as we build our new home.

Our gin still will be powered by the University's solar farm and we will capture the carbon dioxide we produce – a by-product of the fermentation process – to be used for other purposes. We are also working with a company called MiAlgae, who will reuse our process effluent to produce sustainable Omega-3.

In addition to this, we are constantly looking for ways in which we can continue to improve our environmental impact.



A BRAND WITH BIG AMBITION

We recently launched our brand in the USA and have made excellent progress in California with our distributor, Southern Glazers Wine & Spirits.

In February of this year, we activated our brand at The Genesis Invitational. This saw us secure exclusive pouring rights on our gin and advertising across the four days of the tournament and we are currently in talks with the US PGA regarding further activation throughout the coming year.

Going forward, we will continue to expand – with a focus on the golf community – in California, as well as in Arizona, Florida and other select states.

It will then be stored safely in a Fife-based warehouse to mature for ten years. During this time, your whisky will be aged by the oak cask and develop a deep, rich flavour profile.

The primary benefit of this unique offer is for you to have exclusive ownership of one of a small number of casks containing single malt spirit distilled in the Home of Golf, from the only distillery in the world that has, or will ever have, St Andrews in its name.
