- You have all of the following tools:








#### **Parts & Hardware**




#### **Select TV Screws**

1 Hand thread screws into the threaded inserts on the back your TV to determine which Screw diameter to use.

2 Determine whether your TV has a flat back or an irregular or obstructed back.

### **Step 1: Attach TV Bracket**

- 1 Position your TV bracket over your TV hole pattern, making sure the brackets are vertically centered and level.
- Install TV bracket with the screw and washer or spacer you selected for your TV.









# Step 2A: Install Wall Plate on Drywall with Wood Stud

Note: For Concrete skip to Step 2B

- 1 Use the stud finder to locate 2 studs, and then draw a vertical line on the center of each stud.
- Level wall plate and align at center of studs. Make 4 pencil marks to indicate where to drill.










The minimum size of the wood stud must be 1 1/2"x 3 1/2"(38x 89mm) The thickness of dry wall must not exceed


5/8" (16mm).




- 3 Remove the wall plate and drill the pilot holes with a 3/16" drill bit
- 4 Align the wall plate with the pilot holes and insert 4 bolts through the washer in the pilot holes and tighten.

### **Step 2B: Install Wall Plate on Concrete**

- 1 Level the wall plate and make 4 marks with pencil to show where to drill the pilot holes.
- 2 Remove the wall plate and drill the pilot holes with a 3/8" drill bit.










- 3 Insert the anchors into the 4 pilot holes. Tap with hammer
- 4 Align wall plate with pilot holes and anchors. Insert 4 bolts through washers and anchors then tighten with wrench.




### **Step 3: Hang Your TV**

- 1 To hang your TV, clip the TV Rails to the mounted wall plate.
- 2 After the TV is hanging properly on the wall mount, press on the bottom of the TV to lock it in place.
- 3 Fasten 2 screws to secure the bracket.


1 Tilt TV up or down to achieve the best angle of view. No tools required.




## Removing the TV

- 1 Disconnect all cables from the TV.
- 2 Unlock the secure screws.
- 3 Pull bottom of TV from wall, allow enough space to lift TV up and off wall plate.
