

Terminal Crimping Tips

- Disconnect Negative Terminal (Always do this 1st)
- Disconnect Positive Terminal
- Strip 5/8" wire insulation off the battery cable
- Slide the heat shrink over the cable you will crimp the terminal to
- Crimp the cable to the terminal this is tough you either need a B Type

Icrimp B Crimp WS-5100A crimper <u>or</u> Hydraulic crimper (p/n YQK-70) <u>or</u> you can do

it with channel lock pliers and a lot of strength and leverage - (video link below). Make sure the copper wire is crimped tight

- Slide the heat shrink over newly crimped wire and heat to shrink wrap the crimp
- Clean Battery Post with wire brush Add Dielectric Grease (optional)
- Attach Positive Battery Terminal to Positive Battery Post & Ring Terminals
- Attach Negative Battery Terminal to Negative Battery Post
- Spray Terminal Protector / anti-Corrosion to terminal assemblies (optional)
