2019 Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley

Tasting Note: The 2019 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon opens with expressive red fruit, touches of ripe blackberry and red rose petal, hints of vanilla bean, cedar and baking spices complete the aromas. On the palate there are layers of fruit, lively acidity, fine tannins, and touches of oak. These characteristics come together to make a very approachable 100% Cabernet Sauvignon that has a long finish of briar and blackberry.

Additional Notes: This Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon shows classic characteristic of Cabernet Sauvignon from Bordeaux with balanced aromas and flavors and well-integrated tannins that do not overshadow the acidity. The wine changes in the glass as it opens and is allowed to breath. The red fruit becomes deeper and shows more currant than red fruit, touches of raw almond and cigar box come forward while the tannin becomes even more integrated into the wine. The bright acid is the true star of this Cabernet Sauvignon, it is what makes it approachable today and is what will also allow it to age well into the future.

This expression of the well-known Cabernet Sauvignon grape is one that is sure to please and will be the star of any wine dinner. The bright acid and soft tannins allow this wine to pair with almost anything, from salmon or halibut to flank or sirloin steak with roasted seasonal vegetables.
