Below is a list of information regarding the venue and other requirements. Please take the necessary time required to read and understand this document thoroughly.


VENUE

Perth Modern School Beasley Auditorium (in the Beasley Building) 90 Roberts Road, Subiaco

PARKING


The main parking area for the school is the Roberts Rd Car Park no 1 (the grey parking area to the bottom centre of this map and pointed to by the large yellow arrow). Entry is from Roberts Road which is one way (direction of traffic easterly towards Thomas Street).

Overflow parking is available from the Subiaco Road entrance in Carpark no 2 and 3, on the top right of this image.

MUSICAL EQUIPMENT

PIANO

There will be a baby grand piano available on stage for band performances for bands who need it.

ELECTRIC ITEMS

Keyboards, guitars, amplifiers etc. required by bands are to be provided by the band. WABA will not provide these items. Please also bring long extension cords for these items.

PODIUM

There will be a podium available for conductors.

CD PLAYER/SPEAKER FOR SOLOISTS

For soloists and ensembles, a piano will be available (however, there is no official accompanist). If you have a recorded accompaniment, you will be required to provide your own CD player/speaker on the day. We will have an extension cord available if you need to plug your speaker in.

PERCUSSION

Perth Modern School and Darling Range Wind Ensemble are kindly providing the large percussion equipment for the event. The **ONLY** percussion equipment available includes:

If you require any other large equipment, please contact WABA as soon as possible to see if it is available. Bands must provide their own mallets, toys, and small percussion equipment (including equipment such as cowbell, tambourine, triangles and wood blocks). WABA will not provide these on the day, even if they are required by the test piece. Head to the WABA Facebook page closer to the event to see videos of the mechanisms for the timpani, vibraphone and chimes/tubular bells.

PERCUSSION

Due to the risers and a small stage area, percussion equipment is fixed for the 2024 State Championships and can not be moved between bands. Please practice according to the set-up shown on page 11 and help us run on time by not moving equipment on the day.

CATERING

Light food will be available on Saturday and Sunday at the venue. Thanks to AFA Brass Band for providing this service.

DISABLED ACCESS

The main entrance is also the disabled access point. Please contact us at contest@waba.asn.au if you require disabled access to the stage so we can plan appropriately.

RUNNING ON TIME

We will work to run on time for the whole weekend. Please ensure your band members arrive at Perth Modern School 1 hour prior to your scheduled start time. You may be asked to move to the stage up to 10 minutes prior to your scheduled playing time to help the event run to schedule. However, you will only be able to access the warm-up room 40 MINUTES prior to your performance, even if there is no band performing before you.

STAGE LAYOUT

The generic stage layout (as shown on page 10), are as follows,

BRASS BANDS Traditional set-up with 5 chairs in each of the six rows (6 for back-

row cornets), plus additional chairs if required.

CONCERT BANDS Three semi-circular rows at the front (8/12/12) on the floor and

one straight row of 8 on the riser.

Please endeavour to keep to these set plans as close as possible. WABA do not allow for radical redesigns of the seating plan but will make minor changes. If you have questions about your band's seating plan, please email contest@waba.asn.au

STAGE HELP

Bands will be required to send 2 members to the stage to help with setting up the band format. Please note, WABA has a set of WABA stand banners so you are unable to use your own band set. Please do not bring them on the day.




