II. Principal's Report – Jill Price

-*Chip Chip Hooray – This is an event put on by Buckalew celebrating volunteers. Mrs. Points emailed PTO Executive Board, Chairs and Co-chairs, however, if you did not receive an invitation, she personally invited PTO meeting attendees and stated the invitation is in the Buzz.

*Chromebooks from bond exchange will be delivered Monday April 8th.

*4th Grade Color Run: Officially rescheduled for May 3rd with a rain date of May 6th at 9:30 right after specials. Will work with same committee from original sign-up genius for new date.

III. Officer's Reports – PTO Officers

a. Treasurer – Carrie Foster

i. Monthly Financial Report

Revenue:

- We ended the month of March with a YTD revenue of almost \$136k in Gross Revenue or about 92.3% of our overall budget!
 - oWe raised a little over \$400 via Kroger Grocery Rewards; and received almost \$300 from the Spirit night at Gringos
 - •We also have received an additional \$2,700 in revenue that posted to our bank account via direct deposit on <u>April 1st</u> - so this amount will be reflected in <u>next</u> month's numbers.

Expenses:

- We ended the month of March with almost \$16k in Expenses for the month and \$119k for YTD reaching 81.3% of our budget.
- PTO Admin Expenses during March were minimal, consisting of \$147 in storage fees
- PTO Committee Expenses had an uptick due mostly to almost \$1.4k spent on Carnival (Concessions, Misc. Supplies, etc.)
 - Other Committee Expenses totaled almost \$900 and included props for the Entry Way, Books for the vending machine, and Hospitality expenses
- Buckalew Requests in March had a large jump relative to prior months, totaling almost \$12.4k
 - oThe bulk of this expense was for admission on Field Trips (a little over \$5.2k); bus expenses are still TBD
 - Houston Interactive Aquarium 3rd
 - Houston Museum of Natural Science 2nd
 - Once Upon A Cowboy 1st
 - Oil Ranch K
 - Other Buckalew expenses included:
 - A little over \$4k for the renewal of BrainPop software for the 24-25 school year
 - Almost \$2.4k for Grade level needs including books for Kinder, Math Instructional for 4th, and various classroom needs
 - Misc. requests for counseling services and 4th Grade Graduation
 - We also spent an additional \$1.1k on school supplies (which came out of the \$26k funds raised over budget by Boosterthon and approved to be spent in December's meeting)

Net Income:

- Overall, our Net income YTD stands at almost \$16.6k as of the end of March
 - oPlease note that the current amount of Buckalew Expenses <u>unspent</u> vs. budget YTD is roughly \$35k (which is a little over half of what was budgeted)
 - o Given that we anticipate Carnival raising an additional \$30k (net) in April we are still looking good as far our end of the year target
